SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Title of the Project: Diversion of 100.05 Ha. Forest land for Construction of Mahi Banswara Rajasthan Atomic Power Project (MBRAPP)-1 to 4, district- Banswara, Rajasthan. **Proposal No.:** FP/RJ/Others/22621/2016

A proposal has been received from **Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (A Government of India Enterprise), Mumbai, Maharastra** for diversion (under FCA-1980) of **100.05 Ha.** of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction of Mahi Banswara Rajasthan Atomic Power Project (MBRAPP)-1 to 4 in district Banswara, Rajasthan. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 23-04-2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest land measuring 100.05 ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

There are no rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found particularly in the area proposed for diversion. The details of faunal species found around the area proposed for diversion has been mentioned in the proposal.

There are no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.

As per the proposal submitted by the user agency, large numbers of people will be benefited by the Nuclear Power plant, hence in larger public interest 100.05 ha. of forest land is recommended for diversion as proposed by the user agency.
