(iii)	Cost of the project		The Govt. vide GO Rt No.699, PR&RD (P.II) Dept dt.16.11.2017 has accorded sanction of (83) road works with an estimated cost of Rs. 120.89 Crores - PMGSY - LWE Batch I Proposals of 2017-18. For the subject project listed at Sl.no.09 an administrative sanction of Rs.76.00 Lakhs is approved, which includes widening & for maintenance (Rs.4.60 Lakhs). A copy of the said GO is enclosed herewith for ready reference.
(iv)	Justification for locating the project in forest area		The Government of Telangana State has decided for widening and upgradation of existing road to under PMGSY (LWEP). There is much need of the road to the villagers for their daily livelihood and to reach Hospitals, Schools and Collages and to reach nearby market centers to sell their agricultural produce as these villages are facing much troubles. This road is sanctioned to provide connectivity to transport agricultural products and to improve the facilities of remote people under poverty. It is also prioritized by the police department to maintain the law and order in the village and surrounding areas. The length of the road for which administrative sanction is accorded is 1.60Km. Out of the above stretch, existing road to a length of 1246.573M (as per the DGPS authentication received from PCCF office) is passing through Forest Area. As there is no alternative to that of widening of the existing road, proposal is being furnished for diversion of forest land.
