



TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Justification for construction of jeep-able road from Sadam PWD road to Murchal , under Sadam Suntoley GPU, south Sikkim. The sanctioned scheme requires forest clearance as it passes through Upper Sadam Khasmal land.

This project falls in the south district of Sikkim. This road will connect Sadam village with Murchal (which is approximately 25km from Namchi) in south direction. The proposed road is 2km in length. Presently there are no means of vehicular transportation facilities to this village to connect with the District HQ at Namchi and other important towns. The majority of the population are farmers and depend on agriculture. The road on completion will act as a lifeline of the people of the area for the transportation of their agricultural products to the town and help to transport their basic household amenities. It will also help them to reach the District Offices, health care centers, etc. and have easier access to all facilities, which are not available in the village.
