No. II(2)/EF/107/2007 —In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the boundaries of which are specified in the Schedule below, as reserved forest on and from the 28th August 2007.

**BOUNDARIES**

*North and East.*—Starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 43/1, 44 and 45 of 15, Kodivalasa Village, the boundary generally runs towards East along the Southern side of Survey Field Numbers, 44, 9 thence it runs towards South along the Western side of Survey Field Number 43/2 thence towards East along the South side of Survey Field Number 43/2 thence it runs towards North along the Eastern side of Survey Field Number 43/2 thence towards East along the Southern side of Survey Field Numbers 9, 22 and 23 till it reaches the South-East corner of Survey Field Number 23. Thence the boundary runs towards South and thence East along the Western and Southern of Survey Field Number 43/3 Western side of Survey Field Numbers 43/4 and 42 all of 15. Kodivalasa village till it meets the tri-junction point of Survey Field Numbers 42, 43/1 and 55 of 15 Kodivalasa village.

*South.*—Thence the boundary runs towards west and then South along the Northern and western side of Survey Field Number 55, thence the boundary runs towards west along the Northern side of Survey Field Numbers 54, 43/7 till it meets North west corner of Survey Field Number 43/7 thence it runs towards South, West South, East and South west along the western side of Survey Field Numbers 57, 59 till it meets the boundary of Andhra Pradesh thence it runs towards North, west along the Andhra State Boundary till it meets South west corner of Survey Field Number 43/6 thence it runs towards East along the South side of Survey Field Number 43/6 towards North East along East side of Survey Field Number 43/6 towards west along North side of Survey Field Number 43/6 till it meets North west corner of Survey Field Number 43/6 of 15 Kodivalasa village.

*Right 1.*—There is a Temple on the Top of the hill. One pathway with steps leading to Uthaya Murugan Koil is allowed for the public use. There is a Electric line in the pathway. Another electric line at the passes through the habitation joins the electric line in the pathway leading to the temple. The rights of electric line area allowed. Length 270.6 metres. Width 2.0 metres. Permission is also granted to the concerned Department to maintain the Electric line after obtaining necessary prior approval from the Forest Department and to maintain it by the concerned Department. The bearing and distance of the pathway is as follows:—
