JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA

00-33-98 ha. of forest land is required for the construction of Jeori rest house to Nawara Nawaru road and 0-20-00 ha. for dumping. The total length of the road is 2.341 kms which will pass through the forest land. This road is being constructed to provide motor link to villages Nawara and Nawaru. The road will cater to the needs of population of about 400 and will give a boost to the local economy. For the construction of this road and dumping sites 00-53-98 ha. of forest land is required to be diverted. The survey work along with this proposed alignment was already completed.

Since all the beneficiary villages are surrounded by forest. No any other alignment is feasible to connect the village Nawara and Nawaru. If any other alignment is proposed it will require huge area of forest land and large number of trees will be required to be removed.

Hence, there is no escape from using the forest land. This proposed alignment involved lesser no. of forest land, hence finalised for construction of road.
