





NOTES :-

 A relative height, e.g., 200 m, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
 The inverse heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and are not strictly in accordance with them.  
 The kilometre stones along roads, railways and canals are shown in stout type, e.g., 200 m.  
 Unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally non-existent in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.  
 Tanks shown dry in this area usually contain water from July to December.  
 A height, e.g., 200 m, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the bedrock country.  
 Wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
