North.—Starting from a village boundary stone about four chains west of the north-west corner of No. 27 of Ingalligal along the southern boundary of Kariyamur up to south-east corner of No. 1 of that village; then a straight line to the south-west corner of No. 1211 of Kamalapuram; then the south side of that number and No. 1237 to the south-east corner of the latter number; then a straight line to the south-west corner of No. 1211; then the south side of that number to the south-west corner of No. 1209; then a straight line to a point on the latter side about three and a half chains south-west of the south-west corner of No. 1208; then a straight line to that corner; then along the south sides of No. 1208 to a cairn about two chains south-west of the westernmost corner of No. 1217 of Kamalapuram; then a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the south-west corner of No. 1219; then a straight line to the westernmost corner of that number; then the south side of that number to its south-east corner; then a straight line in a north-easterly direction to a cairn on the west side of the Papinayakanahalli-Kamalapuram cart-track about two and a half chains west of the south-west corner of No. 1167 of Kamalapuram. East.—Then along the west side of the said cart-track up to a cairn about three chains east of the north-east corner of No. 8 of Papinayakanahalli.

North.—Then a straight line to the north-east corner of No. 6; then the north and west sides of that number to its westernmost corner; then a straight line due west for about eleven chains to a cairn on the west side of No. 4; then a straight line to the northernmost corner of No. 122 (all the above numbers are of Papinayakanahalli); then a straight line to north-east corner of No. 3 of Ingalligal; then the north and west sides of that number and the north side of No. 4 up to the north-west corner of the latter number; then a straight line to the 1st survey stone on the west side of that number counting from its north-west corner (all the above numbers are of Ingalligal); then a straight line to the north-east corner of No. 27 of Vaddirhalli; then along the northern boundary of Vaddirhalli to the second village boundary stone on the north side of No. 66; then the north side of that number and No. 64 to the north-west corner of the latter number (all the above numbers are of Vaddirhalli); then the north side of No. 184 of Ingalligal to its north-west corner; then a straight line to the north-east corner of No. 180.
No. 1210.	No. 122,	Bhillimalu West.	North.—From a straight line to the south-east corner of No. 109; then the east sides of that number and No. 94 to the boundary stone near the north-east corner of the latter number; then a straight line to the south-east corner of No. 75; then a straight line north-east by north to a cairn on the south side of No. 61 about six and a half chains east of the south-east corner of No. 71; then the south sides of Nos. 61, 62 and 63 and the south, east and north sides of No. 65 up to its north-west corner; then a straight line to the north-east corner of No. 63; then the north sides of that number and Nos. 62, 64 and 72 up to the north-west corner of the last number; then a straight line north-east by north to the south-east corner of No. 66; then the east and north sides of that number to the 2nd survey stone on the latter side counting from its north-east corner; then a straight line to the north-west corner of No. 60; then a straight line to the south-east corner of No. 47; then the east and north sides of that number to its north-west corner; then a straight line to the easternmost corner of No. 47; then the north side of that number to its north-west corner; then a straight line due west to the starting point.
