

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MOEF), Government of India's Letter NO. 11-0/98-FC(pt) Dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose. It is certified that 2.12 Hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Indian Army in West Kameng District, Arunachal Pradesh falls within jurisdiction of Sessa village in Bhalukpong circle.
