## SITE INSPECTION REPORT

I along with the User Agency (Representatives from R & B), Forest Divisional Officer, Kamareddyand Forest Range Officer, Nagireddypetand field staff inspected the proposed area for diversion of **2.121 Ha.** of Forest land in Sy. No. 86 situated at Tandoor (V) Nagireddypet (Mandal0 for formation of approach road to Main work "construction of HLB across Manjeera River from Dharmareddy to Muddapur via Venkampally road "in favour of Executive Engineer (R&B) Division Kamareddy of Kamareddy Districtwhich is passing from reserve forest area in Kamareddy Division. The proposed area is passing through Compt. No. 695 of Tandur R.F Dharmareddy Beat of Nagireddypet Section of Nagireddypet Range in Kamareddy division of Kamareddy district.

The undersigned has inspected the proposed road area passing through Compt.No.695 and width of the road is 20 mtrs and length is 1060.60 Mts. The Forest Range Officer, Nagireddpet has enumerated the trees which are falling in Tandur R.F. (9) Trees in Compt. No.695. The species Sissoo(Dalbergiasissoo), major are Nemalinara (Holopteliaintegrifolia), Tuniki (Diospyros melanoxylon), Palakodisha (Wrightiatinctoria), Moduga (Butea monosperma), Nidraganneru (Samaneasaman), Pachathurayi (Peltophorumpterocarpum), Errathurayi (Delonixregia), Simmathagidu (Cassia sammia) etc., Further, there is an avenue plantation stretch of 4 kms before the initial entry point into RF and about 400 plants (1 km) raised during 2014-15 will be affected by this proposal. The then District Forest Officer, Kamareddy test checked the same and found to be correct. The canopy density of the proposed forest area is 0.0 to 0.2.

The said forest area proposed for diversion does not form part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. There are no protected Archaeological / Heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument in the forest area proposed for diversion.

As per the report of the Forest Range Officer, Nagireddypet, the aerial distance of proposed area for diversion from the Pocharam wildlife sanctuary and Eco sensitive zone of Pocharam wildlife sanctuary is 11.3 Km and 5.93Km respectively.

Within the impact zone of the said project, wild animals and birds such Hysterixindica (Porcupine), Lepus nigricollis (Hare), Boselaphustragocamelus(Nilgai), Axis axis (Spotted Deer), Sus scropha (Wild Boar), Pavocristatus (Indian Peafowl), Glaucidiumradiatum (Jungle Owlet), Terpsiphone paradise (Paradise Flycatcher), Bucerosbicornis (Hornbill) etc., which are listed in the various schedules of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 are present and seen freely moving by the field staff and certain indirect signs are observed during the field visit.



This is the barest minimum area i.e., required for construction of HLB across Manjeera River from Dharmareddy to Muddapur via Venkampally road PR Road in Kamareddy Division of Kamareddy District. The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest conservation Act 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction. The area is free from encroachment.

The proposal for Diversion of 2.121 Ha. of Forest land in Sy. No. 86 situated at Tandoor (V) Nagireddypet Mandal for formation of approach road to Main work "construction of HLB across Manjeera River from Dharmareddy to Muddapur via Venkampally road "in favour of Executive Engineer (R&B) Division Kamareddy of Kamareddy District is **recommended** in public interest subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The proposed area has presence of large boulders and sheet rock. The UA shall take prior permission before carrying out any blasting of boulders.
- 2. The User Agency shall place speed breakers at suitable locations in order to avoid road induced mortality of wild animals.
- UA shall erect boards stating the forest and wildlife conservation messages to raise awareness, details such legal status of the proposed forest area, area diverted etc in consultation with DFO Kamareddy.

4. UA should ensure protection of forest and wildlife from fire.
