The Scheduled Tribe and Other Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 generally known as Forest Rights Act is under enforcement. However, the process of identification of right holders and its extent is slow. As a result, the implementation of our 3rd August, 2009 letter is getting delayed.

A number of strategically important roads under construction in the border areas are getting delayed. Keeping in view the urgency, location of these roads and their importance from the defence point of view, it is felt that for the time being the construction of these roads be permitted on implementation of stipulations in the approval order other than the compliance of 3rd August, 2009 letter.
