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ii.a	For the proposed diversion of 4.46ha of forest land, compensatory land has been identified by the user agency in S.F.No. 96/1 of Vedhanarayanapuram village of Chengalpattu District and compensatory afforestation has been proposed in 8.92 ha of degraded forest area in Gudalur RF and reported that since the selected CA land is already having vegetation and forest like Characteristics, Compensatory afforestation plantation cannot be taken up in the CA land For doing 8092 ha of plantation, an amount of	
	Rs. 2,76,21,047/- has been proposed including 10 years maintenance work. For doing 8.92 ha plantation work, above amount seems very high (Pro rata amount of Rs. 30,96,530/- per ha.)	Based on the model estimate approved by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Chennai vide C.No.TS4/22483/2022 dt: 21.02.2023, now the total financial outlay for CA scheme for 8920Nos. (8.92ha) has been worked out and revised as Rs.153.35lakhs and the estimates for raising nursery, planting and 10years maintenance of plantation have also been uploaded with necessary corrections.

v	In the site inspection and recommendation of the proposal, the District Forest Officer has reported that, diversion of forest area of 4.46ha proposed in Vandalur RF, which includes 1.25ha Vandalur RF under Modern Nursery Perungalathur Research wing Details about any damage to the property of Research wing caused and NOC obtained from the Research wing ha not been reported	Revised site inspection report has been uploaded stating the damage of properties during execution of proposed work. As the ownership of Reserve Forest area 4.46ha. remains with the Chennai Forest Division, it is not necessary to obtain NOC from the Research wing Perungalathur. The area of 1.25ha. proposed for diversion in Research wing can be compensated by allotting equivalent alternate area in the same Reserve Forest area.
vi	Forest area diversion of 4.46ha has been requested in Vandalur RF. KML file uploaded by the User Agency has been rechecked and area of KML file uploaded measures as 4.48ha as against the proposal of 4.46ha. this may be corrected.	The corrections have been communicated and made by the User Agency.
vii	As per the KML file uploaded and location marked in the Survey of India topo sheet, proposed diversion of forest area for formation of Tambaram Eastern Bypass Road starts in the middle of the forest area from the Perungalathur road. Details about road portion connecting the edge of the Road with the existing road has not been reported. Further, details about whether the existing road lies in the forest area or any Right of way is available for the existing road/permission if any previously obtained from the Forest Department for the existing road have not been reported.	The proposed road diversion of Eastern Bypass starting point links with the end portion of Road Over Bridge (ROB) proposed by Highways Department vide Pro.No.FP/TN/Road/151930/2022 and the end portion of the proposed road connects with the newly formed bypass road out side the Reserve Forest in Alapakkam village. The road which is already existing and passing through the Reserve Forest is a right of way.
