



Minutes of 27th meeting of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) held on 03. 01.2019 under the chairmanship of Sh. Anand Mohan Sharan, IAS, Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Urban Local Bodies Department - cum- Chairperson of the SLTC under AMRUT.

27th meeting of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and urban Transformation (AMRUT) was held on 03.01.2019 under the Chairmanship of Sh. Anand Mohan Sharan, IAS, Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Urban Local Bodies Department-cum-Chairperson of the SLTC. The list of the participants is enclosed as Annexure -I.

At the outset, Chief Engineer, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana welcomed the Chairman and members of the Committee. The committee members were apprised of the upto date progress of AMRUT project. Thereafter, agenda items were discussed:

Agenda 27.1: Confirmation of the minutes of 26^h meeting of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) held on 03.12.2018.

Minutes of 26th meeting of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) held on 03.12.2018 were circulated to all the members vide DULB office Memo No. XEN-I/DULB/2018/12920, Dt: 03.12.2018. No comments have been received from any of the members.

The minutes of the 26th meeting were confirmed by Committee.

AGENDA 27.2 Approval for change of clause of registration of Joint Venture.

CE, DULB explained that In the following works allotted to the agencies, the clause of Memorandum of Understanding/Joint Venture/Consortium Agreement was incorporated as under:

"The JV/ consortium agreement at the time of submission of Bid shall be allowed as unincorporated. In the event the bid of JV/Consortium is accepted and after the issuance of Letter of Award (LOA), the JV/ Consortium shall incorporate a new company under the Companies Act,2013/1956. In case, the bidder fails to observe/comply with this stipulation before signing the agreement, the full earnest money deposit

shall be forfeited and other penal action shall be taken against all the members of JV/ Consortium, which must be complied with." --- (A)

The above agencies/ JVs approached this office with the practical problems stating that the registration under companies Act, 2013/1956 requires to create a new company which will entail lot of time to constitute and a cumbersome procedure shall have to be followed for forming the new company. These JVs/consortiums have approached DULB to allow the registration either under Companies Act, 1956/2013 or under Registration Act,1908. The inclusion in the provision for registration of JVs/consortiums under Registration Act, 1908 will facilitate the process and enable them to complete all the formalities in time for signing the agreement

CE further explained that as on date, 39 works have been allotted to contractual agencies under AMRUT Project. It has been noticed that in all other 27 tender cases, following clause was incorporated in place of above clause:

"On issue of letter of Award (LOA), an agreement amongst the members of the JV firm (to whom work has been awarded) has to be executed and got registered before the Registrar/ Sub-Registrar under the Registration Act, 1908 or under Companies Act, 1956 . This agreement shall be submitted to the engineer-in-Charge before signing the contract agreement for the work. In case, the bidder fails to observe/comply with this stipulation, the full earnest money deposit shall be forfeited and other penal action shall be taken against all the partners of JV firm." --- (B)

It is mentioned here that the replacement of clause as at (A) with clause as at (B) will not lead to providing any financial benefit to the agencies nor it shall lead to any other loss to the department. However, all the other formalities as stipulated in Agreements shall remain unchanged entailing all the penal actions against all the members of JV/ Consortium for non compliance of terms and conditions mentioned in DNIT.

As explained above, it was recommended that in case of above 12 No. allotted works the clause of JV as per (A) may be replaced with clause as per (B).

The Committee deliberated the issue. The members of the Committee pointed out that this issue involves alteration of DNIT conditions post allotment of work which may have legal implications.

SLTC decided to forward the case to the Legal Remembrancer, Haryana for getting legal opinion before the case is finally decided by the Committee.

AGENDA 27.3 Detail Project Report for Drainage scheme Sonapat.

CE, DULB explained that:

- Work from RD 1900 M to 6706 M of drain no. 6, Sonapat has already been allotted to M/s MSKEL-Garg JV against agreement amount of Rs. 87.00 Cr. and the work is in progress.
- Hon'ble CM Haryana announced to channelise the balance length of the 6706 M to 9300 M vide announcement no. 22239 dated 16.06.2018. Since area from 0 RD to 1900 M RD also falls in the jurisdiction of MC, Sonapat, as such, this reach was also included in the DPR.
- Accordingly, to channelized the the drain No. 6 from RD 0 to 9300 M with RCC Box Drain, DPR for re-modelling of drain no. 6 from RD 0 to

1900 M and RD 6706 to RD 9300 M were prepared under AMRUT Project costing Rs. 61.51 Cr.

- Now, Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat through Commissioner, MC Sonapat has informed the ULB department to delete the provision for re-modelling of drain no. 6 from RD 0 to 1900 M as presently this reach is not required to be taken up.
- Accordingly, the provision of construction of drain no. 6 from RD 0 to RD 1900 has been deleted. As such the cost of DPR has been reduced from Rs. 61.51 Cr. to Rs. 42.50 Cr. for RD 6706 M to RD 9300 M only.

Scope of work of DPR in brief is as under:

The Committee perused the agenda and approved the DPR for Rs. 42.50 Cr. for RD 6706 M to RD 9300 M only.

AGENDA 27.4 Revision of State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) under AMRUT Haryana.

CE Explained that:

- State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) for year 2015-16 was approved by Apex Committee of Govt. of India approved the SAAP for year 2015-16 in its 3rd meeting held on 26.11.2015 amounting to Rs. 438.02 Cr. with Central and State Share of Rs. 219.01 Cr. each towards the project cost after the approval by Sate High Powered Committee (SHSPC) in its 1st meeting dated 09.11.2015.
- Modified State Annual Action Plan (SAAP-I) for the year 2015-16 amounting to Rs. 458.02 Cr. was approved in 2nd meeting of SHSPC held on 24.06.2016 and was finally approved in the in the 12th meeting of GoI Apex Committee held on 03.08.2016. The Central Share remained the same as Rs. 219.01 Cr. and the State Share as Rs. 239.01 Cr., as already approved.
- State Annual Action Plan for the year 2016-17 was also approved in 2nd meeting of SHSPC for Rs. 525.40 cr. and finally approved in the 12th meeting of Apex Committee for Rs. 525.40 Cr. with Central share as Rs. 254.40 cr. & State share as Rs. 271.00 cr.
- The SAAP-III (2017-20) amounting to Rs. 1582.32 cr. with Central share of Rs. 291.10 cr. and State share of Rs. 1291.22 cr. (including

convergence amount by State of Rs. 964.82 cr.) after the approval by SHPSC in its third meeting held on 07.11.2016 was placed before GoI Apex Committee in its 17th meeting held on 15.03.2017. Apex Committee considered the SAAP-III proposal and found to be in order, however, decided to with hold the approval of SAAP-III till the desired progress is achieved by State.

CE further explained that:

- A letter, D.O. No. K-14012/150/2015-SC-II/AMRUT-II dated 11.07.2017 (Copy placed at **Annexure RS-11**) was received from Director AMRUT, wherein it was mentioned that city wise and sector wise break up of cost of projects of SAAP-I differ considerably in the provisions made in SAAP-II & III. It was requested to submit the detailed SAAP-I (revised) for the year 2015-16 to the Ministry.
- Accordingly the SAAP I, II & III have again been revised keeping in view the actual requirements of funds for each project. The provision for each project has been taken as per site requirement, scope of work has been taken in the approved DPRs and DNITs and major works allotted. The works earlier proposed in the SAAPs under Urban Transport head are not required at present as the works of path ways/walkways and cycle tracks as per requirements shall be executed by the ULBs from their own resources. The procurement of buses shall be done by State Transport Department through their own resources. Scope of work for Drainage system & Parks have decreased as per site requirements. More funds are required for Water Supply & Sewerage works as new colonies at various towns have been approved by State Govt. and some sectors areas have also been transferred from HUDA to ULBs
- It has been proposed to utilize the funds under Urban Transport, Drainage and Parks for Water Supply and Sewerage projects being priority sectors. Accordingly State Annual Action Plans have been revised. The overall amount of Revised SAAP-I (2015-16), SAAP-II (2016-17) & SAAP-III (2017-20) and Total SAAP (2015-20) remains the same as already approved by GoI of India. The Central and State share also remains same. Only changes are made in the projects wise & city wise cost of the Revised SAAPs (SAAP-I, II & III).
- There is no change in the overall amount of revised SAAP from the approved SAAP I (2015-16), SAAP-II (2016-17) and SAAP-III (2017-20) and overall SAAP (2015-20). However, there are changes in the city wise project cost and sector wise amount for the approved projects. The sector wise difference in cost is, for water supply=6.95%, sewerage = 10.50%, Drainage = (-) 9.75%, Urban Transport = (-) 100% and parks = (-) 64.87%.
- As per para 8.4 of modified mission guidelines, the SHPSC is competent to approve replacement of the projects costing upto 10% of each SAAP. In view of the above, the Revised SAAPs (SAAPs-I, II & III) are placed

before the State Level Technical Committee for approval so that these Revised SAAPs can be placed before the State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPS) for further approval before the same is recommended to MoHUA for final approval of revised SAAP by the Apex Committee.

The SLTC considered and approved the proposed revised SAAPs SAAP-I (2015-16), SAAP-II (2016-17) & SAAP-III (2017-20) for recommending the same to SHPS for further submission to the Apex Committee for final approval.

01. Team Leader, WAPCOS informed as under:

- DNIT for the work was approved for Rs. 28.50 Cr. by SLTC in its 22nd meeting held on 22.10.2018. The salient feature of the DNIT are presented in agenda.
- 2 bidders participated in the bid. The bids were evaluated by Technical Evaluation Committee. Both the bidders were found to be technically eligible.
- Financial bids of both the eligible bidders were opened on 27.12.2018. Rates /amount quoted by the bidders were as under:-

02. Tender Evaluation committee under the chairmanship of Chief Engineer, ULB HQ held a meeting on 27.12.2018 for justification of rates of lowest bidder.
03. The representative of the agency stated that his quoted rates are competitive and justified in view of the prevailing market prices and scope of work as well as specifications included in the DNIT.
04. The representative of the lowest bidder **M/s Shree Balaji Builders JV** (M/s. Jagram Bass L&C Co. Op. Society Co.+ M/s. Rajeev Kumar Goel Contractor, Jind) was called in person before the SLTC and persuaded him to reduce his rates. The representative of the agency informed the committee that due to following reasons the higher rates above the DNIT are demanded:-
- ✓ Market rates of the DI pipes have increase by 5-10% after quoting the tender.
 - ✓ The steel rates based on HSR taken in the DNIT are much lesser than the prevailing market rates.
 - ✓ The agency has intimated that there is no provision of escalation of price clause regarding labour component and other material provided in the DNIT except Cement and Steel.
05. However, after great persuasion, the L1 agency **M/s Shree Balaji Builders JV** agreed to reduce his rates from +18.17 % to + 18% over the DNIT Cost.

The Committee considered the matter and accepted the reduced rate of M/s Shree Balaji Builders JV (M/s. Jagram Bass L&C Co. Op. Society Co.+ M/s. Rajeev Kumar Goel Contractor, Jind) for an amount of Rs. 33,62,50,820/- i.e. 18 % above DNIT Cost.

- First time 2 bidders participated in the bid against Tender ID 104327. Out of 2 bidders only one bidder i.e. M/s. Brij Gopal Construction Co. New Delhi found technically eligible.
- Second time again only one bidder participated against Tender ID 106815 (while keeping bids of Tender ID 104327 alive.)
- Both the bids were evaluated by Technical Evaluation Committee. Both the bidders were found to be technically eligible.
- Financial bids of the both eligible bidders were opened on 27.12.2018. Rates /amount quoted by the bidders were as under:-

02. Tender Evaluation committee under the chairmanship of Chief Engineer, ULB HQ held a meeting on 27.12.2018 for justification of rates of lowest bidder.

03. The representative of the agency stated that his quoted rates are competitive and justified in view of the prevailing market prices and scope of work as well as specifications included in the DNIT.

04. The representative of the lowest bidder **M/s. KB-PKJ JV** (M/s. Khukhrain Builders and M/s. Parveen Kumar Jain) was called in person before the SLTC and persuaded him to reduce his rates. The representative of the agency informed the committee that due to following reasons the higher rates above the DNIT are demanded:-

- ✓ Market rates of the DI pipes have increase by 5-10% after quoting the tender.
- ✓ The steel rates based on HSR taken in the DNIT are much lesser than the prevailing market rates.
- ✓ The agency has intimated that there is no provision of escalation of price clause regarding labour component and other material provided in the DNIT except Cement and Steel.

05. However, after great persuasion, the L1 agency **M/s. KB-PKJ JV** agreed to reduce his rates from +20.22 % to 18.50 % over the DNIT Cost.

The Committee considered the matter and accepted the reduced rate of M/s. KB-PKJ JV (M/s. Khukhrain Builders and M/s. Parveen Kumar Jain). for an amount of Rs. 31,57,51,134/- i.e. 18.50 % above DNIT Cost.
