In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of letter No. 11-9/98.FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of road from PWD Road to Neelavancha Village of Gudur Mandal under PMGSY Phase-X vide GO.Ms.No.362, PR&RD (Progs.II) Dept., Dt.09.11.2012, it is certified that 3.816 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Panchayath Raj Enigneer, Mahabubabad District falls within jurisdiction of Grama Panchayath of Matwada Village of Gudur Mandal.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 3.816 Hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub- Division Level, Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.
