

Conservation value of the protected area
--Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary, Gandachara Dhalai Tripura

Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary with an area of 389.54 Sq. Km. spread over in Dhalai, Khowai and Gumti District of Tripura. This Sanctuary has variety of Flora and Fauna having adequate ecological, faunal, floral, natural or zoological significance. The Sanctuary is declared for the purpose of protecting, propagating, developing wildlife and its environment. Certain rights of people living inside the Sanctuary could be permitted. Further, during the settlement of claims, before finally notifying the Sanctuary, the Collector may, in consultation with the Chief Wildlife Warden, allow the continuation of any right of any person in or over any land within the limits of the Sanctuary. Net present value of forest land of 14.564466 hectare is Rs.70,00,000/-per ha.


Gumti Wildlife Sanctuary is well known for its rich greenery, pleasant climate, scenic beauty and Dumboor Reservoir, Comprising a total area of 389.54Sq.Km.This is a representative of Bio-Geographic Zone 9B of the North East Hills and plays a key role in maintaining regional connectivity in the otherwise fragmented Forest Tracts. It had been declared as a wildlife Sanctuary in the year 1988.The vegetation of the sanctuary comprises four sorts of forests such as "the tropical semi evergreen forest", "the East Himalayan Bhabar sal, "Moist blended deciduous woods" and "the Savannah forest". Barking Dears, Himalayan Black Bear and migratory birds are the attraction of this Sanctuary.

Flora: The vegetation of the sanctuary includes Cachar Tropical Evergreen Forests, the East Himalayan Lower Bhabar Sal, Moist Mixed deciduous Forest, Moist Mixed deciduous Forest with Dry Bamboo Brakes and Secondary Moist Bamboo Brakes. The under storey of the sanctuary is covered with plenty of shrubs, herbs, bushes, climbers and grass.


Fauna: Major attractions of the sanctuary are the Deer, Hollock Gibbon, Spectacle Monkey, Himalayan Black Bear, wild boar, Wild Cat, Rhesus Monkey, Pig Tailed Monkey etc. It is likewise a home to the reptiles. Diverse types of resident birds and migratory birds might be effectively spotted here due to presence of Dumboor reservoir and dense vegetation.
