BRIEF NOTE TO IMPROVEMENTS TO KURUPAM - MULIGUDA ROAD TO BEERUPADU FROM KM 8/0 TO 24/6 (DERUWADA TO BEERUPADU) IN GUMMALAKSHMIPURAM MANDAL IN VIZIANAGARAM DISTRICT.

The main objective of the scheme is to connect the interior villages to nearest market places, there by providing infrastructure facilities to the cillages which in turn will slove un employment problem of poor tribes living in remote areas. They will also help in improving the social life of the tribes.

The proposed Road " Deruwada to Beerupadu" is to serve the habitation (Tribal) having a population of 4071 members. It is required to bring this tribal population into normal civilization by providing this road. By laying this road , the poor tribes living in remote areas can transport the Non Timber Forest Produce collected from the nearest shandies for sale. The Government Organization like Girijan Co - Operative Societies will directly make contacts with the Tribal peopole and they will buy the forest products without mediation of brokers. There by the tribals will get benefited by getting better income and become better civilzed. The value of the Forest products bought by Girijan Co - Operative Corporation is nearly Rs.21.00 Crores. Hence the cost benefit ratio is 5.25:1 , which is more economical for laying of this road. Hence this road may be sanctioned.
