



NET PRESENT VALUE (NPV) BILL

- Name of the Project** : Diversion of Forest land for construction of Rural connectivity Road from Narkhola to Upper Narkhola & Lower Narkhola in West Sikkim.
- User Agency** : Rural Development Department, Gyalshing, Govt. of Sikkim
1. **Area of forest land proposed for diversion** : 1.0428 Ha. of Forest land
2. **Crop Density** : above 30%
3. **Rate of NPV notification (as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dt 15th May, 2008)** : Rs. 8,45,000 per Ha for Eco class V (dense forest)
4. **Net Present Value (NPV) bill** : Rs.8,81,166.00

The Middle Hill forests area falls under the proposed diversion of 1.0482 Ha. of Forest land for construction of rural connectivity road from Narkhola to upper Narkhola & lower Narkhola in West Sikkim. It has been categorized as Sub-Tropical broad leaved hill forests under Eco-Class V in accordance with the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 15th May 2008. The crop density of the forestland is 30%, it has been further categorized as dense forest (as per State of Forest Report, 2019). So, Forest land with Eco Class V rate of Rs. 8,45,000/- per Ha was taken. Therefore the Net Present Value of 1.489 Ha. of forest land diverted is calculated amounts to **Rs 8,81,166.00**

(Rupees Eight Lakhs Eighty One Thousand One Hundred Sixty Six) only.
