
Dear Shri Oberoi,

Please refer to your D.O. letter No.NH/CMD/73/6697 dated 26.11.85 regarding forest clearance and afforestation scheme of Uri Hydro Electric Project. I am please to inform you that this Department has no objection for the utilisation of 54.708 ha. of forest land for Uri Hydro Electric Project in J&K, subject to the following conditions:

1. Legal status of the land should remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation should be raised over an equivalent non-forest land at the cost of the project.
3. Free supply of fuelwood to the labour and staff engaged in the project work should be ensured or the cost of fuelwood should be defrayed against their salary/wages.
4. Vacant space available in the project area should be planted up with the suitable ~~spp.s~~ species
