FULL JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA (UN-AVOIDANCE OF THE FOREST AREA FOR THE PURPOSE)

The existing road between Haliya to Nagarjunasagar is narrow BT road and has been declared as National Highway and the road is not to the national highway standards and cannot handle the increased highway traffic. The road length of 0.935 Km passing in the reserve forest is a part and parcel of NH565 and needs to widen it to national highway standards. There is no alternative path for the same. Now after declaration of NH the road from Km 1/0 to 86/057 which is passing in Nalgonda district is sanctioned for improvements and it is essential widen the road length of 0.935 Km passing through reserve forest to give good connectivity between the two states Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

DETAILED NOTE ON THE PROJECT

The road from Nakrekal in Telangana to Erpedu in Andhra Prades is recently declared as National Highway by GOI and assigned National Highway number NH-565. Now rehabilitation and up gradation of the reach from Nakrekal to Nagarjunasagar in Nalgonda district i.e., from Km 1/0 to 86/057 is sanctioned by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MORT&H), GOI for Rs. 270.00 corers and the work is entrusted to the agency for execution.

This Project corridor is an important connectivity between NH-65 and NH-71 in the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh respectively. Widening and improvement of this section of NH-565 would further improve the connectivity in terms of achieving smooth and safe traffic flow and improve level of service. In addition to above, substantial economic gain in terms of reduced Vehicle Operating Cost (VOC) and reduced travel time will be achieved.

The reach from Km. 72/460 to 73/395 (0.935 Km) which passes through reserve forest area of Nellikal reserve forest and part of Amrabad tiger reserve wild life sanctuary is a part and parcel of NH565. The existing formation width of the road is 10.00 m which is insufficient to cater the need of the highway traffic. As such it is proposed to widen the road. The total area of widening is worked out to 0.9723 Ha.
