JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

Name of Work: Press Club Building at Changer Sector Bilaspur (HP)

The Joint Inspection of the Press Club Building at Changer Sector Bilaspur (HP) was done on dated 17-06-2022. The land was examined for alternate route to avoid/minimize the use of forest land. The joint inspection team has come to the conclusion that proposed forest land comprising the Khasra number as per the detail given below is absolutely essential and the land required for the project is maximum required for execution of above scheme. The land record duly attested showing the area proposed for diversion of non-forest use with the joint inspection report is tabulated below;

During this joint inspection Two alternative sites have been examined which are as below.

Alternative- 1 (Proposed Area):-

Under this Alternative, the proposed Land for Press Club Building a Changer Sector Bilaspur (HP) for the diversion of 0.02885 Hectare Forest Land (Under FCA 1980) tor Non-Forestry Purpose.

Alternative-2:-

Under this Alternative, the proposed Land for Press Club Building at Changer Sector Bilaspur (HP) for the diversion of 0.020 Hectare Forest Land (Under FCA 1980) for Non-Forestry Purpose.

Since the involvement or one forest land as on the lesser side in accountive-1, so the Alternative -1 has been recommended.

On Inspection of the site, it is found that

- 1. For the construction of the proposed scheme, total area of forest land will be 0.02885 Hectare.
- 2. The proposed land is minimum or unavoidable for the construction of said scheme.
- 3. In the above area, there is no species of vegetation which is prone to extinction.
- 4. There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area. 5. The user agency has not violated the provision of Forest Conservation, act 1980
- 6. Therefore the proposed area is declared compulsory and inaccessible or there will be no change in this. Even saying that this matter is related to national and public interest, Recommendation for approval under Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

Therefore the said proposed and inspected area is found technically most suitable area meeting all the criteria of Forest Department as well as User Agency.
