

NOTES :-

A relative heights, .8r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals and protective embankments is required

Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown. A relative height e.g. . 4r , marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country, whereas that along drain represents the height of the top of the embankment

Distance stones along canals and protective embankment are 1,000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown, except along Ghuman Distributary, Talwandi Distributary and Kotla Branch (SIRHIND CANAL) where these are 5,000 feet apart and every existing one is shown. Most of the unlined well symbols indicate covered tank, called Kunds, which usually contain surface collection of rainwater.
