DETAIL NOTE ABOUT THE PROJECT

The forest land is required for the Construction of Link Road from Kanol to Morch Road Km 0/0 to 9/140 comprising forest lands of Batuni, Kanol & Lag. The length of Proposed Road is 9.140 km, out of which 7980 meters length passes through forest land and 1160 meters length passes through private land. The total land involve in this alignment is 5.1195 hectare (including dumping site) out of which 4.5259 hectares passes through forest land and 0.5936 hectare passes through private land. The total no. of trees will be involve in the alignment is 383 nos. which will required to be removed. The Scheme will cover one forest division, i.e. Dharamshala Forest Division.

With the construction of this road a population of 1411 people will be benefited and the land of the area is very fertile in growing cash crop viz. potatoes, pulses and other seasonal crops etc. But at present in the absence of the motor able road the people of these villages are facing great difficulties in carrying their cash crops timely to the market and also in carrying the essential commodities/ daily needs etc. They have to pay huge amount on account of manual carriage of cash crops and essential commodities, the local product cannot be sent to the well in time and the growers cannot get the proper values of their cash crops with the result that the people of the area are becoming poor to poorer day by day.

Cost of Project

The total estimated cost of the project is approximately Rs. 4.10 Crore

Plantation Method:

Nursery grown one year old plants (in polythene bags as well as naked roots) will be planted in 30X30X30cm. and 45X45X45cm. pits in the selected area. Bush cutting will be done in the infested area. The plantation will be maintained for subsequent 8 years in which beating up of failures will be done. The plantation will be rain fed.

Protection of Plantation:

Planted area will be protected from grazing by erecting the barbed wire fencing all around the plantation. Further watch and ward and fire protection will be ensured through regular departmental staff.
