NOTIFICATION

Jaipur, August 5, 1978.

No. 523(16)Rev/8/76.- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 29 of the Rajasthan Forest Act (Rajasthan) Act No. XIII of 1953), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby declares the strips of lands whether under tree growth or not on either side of the metalled roads under control of P.W.D., transferred to the Forest Department for management, as per Schedule appended herewith, to be protected forests and the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act and the rules made thereunder to be applicable to them;

In further pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 30 thereof, the Governor of Rajasthan further declares that the trees, shrubs, grasses and other vegetation growing on the said strips of protected forest are reserved with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette and prohibits from the aforesaid date, the cutting, ~~damage to the vegetation, removal~~
~~wasting, setting fire or causing damage to the vegetation, removal~~
lopping, pollarding, uprooting, setting fire or causing damage to the vegetation, removal of any forest produce in the said forests and breaking up or clearing for cultivation or for building, for grazing of cattle or for any other purpose, of any land in the said forest.
