A justification for locating the project in forest land may also be submitted by the State Government. Aerial distance between the Right Bank Canal of the Project agency has submitted revised proposal for Bawanthadi MI Project and Sorna Dams is approximately 3.99 Km. measuring 6.537 ha. 3.6 km, while the construction of the feeder canal has been proposed over a lengh of 1.4 Km. The State Government may therefore, provide a map on appropriate scale, conspicuously depicting, complete detail of proposed feeder canal from the right bank canal viii of Bawanthadi project of Sorna MI project along with the detail of forest area involved thereof.
