


No. 516/2012/DC/UKL : In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(Pt) dated 03/08/2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences of having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled tribe and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (recognition of Forest Rights Act 2006 ("FRA" for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, **it is certified** that 0.979493 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Department of Tourism, Government of Manipur for establishment of Khangkhui Mangsor Cave as Tourist destination falls within the jurisdiction of Khangkhui Khullen village in Ukhrul District, Manipur.

It is further certified that –

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the 0.979493 hectares of area proposed for diversion.
- b) The Diversion of forest land for facilities, managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of FRA is being processed.
- c) The proposal does not involve recognised rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities.
