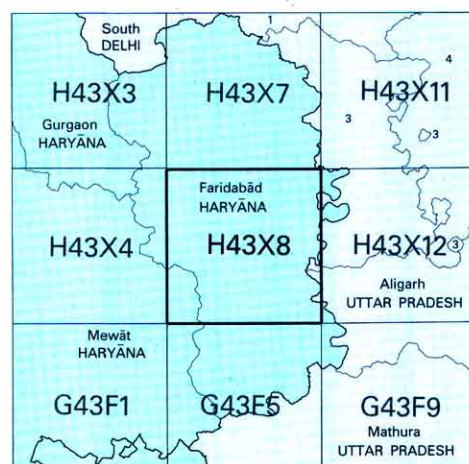

A relative height, e.g., δ , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Unsettled lands are shown in this sheet as generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
The areas adjoining the Yamuna River and Jar Nalla are liable to change owing to continual fluctuations in the courses of the river and the nalla.
