The State Government will intimate the packages to be tendered in the 1" batch and nake entries on OMMAS accordingly before proceeding with the tendering process. 3.

While recommending these proposals in Para 1 above, the Committee also made the 4 following observations:

The State Government should reconcile the difference between figures of OMMAS and MPRs. The State should ensure that the OMMAS data must be updated immediately (i) since it is linked with released of funds to the State.

ATR on accounting and financial management issues raised in the meeting of EC should (II) be furnished at the earliest.

- The State needs to submit the soft copies of the maps and data to NRRDA for record, to (iii) verify the compatibility of the proposals in future phases.
- Citizen Information Boards should be displayed in the local language in the prominent (iv) locations of the target habitations.
