

## Short narrative of proposal

This proposal envisages diversion of 390.264 ha forest land under section 2 of forest Conservation Act 1980 for Bina Kakari amalgamation OCP coal mine of Northern Coalfields Limited, Singrauli (M.P.). The above forest land includes 370.152 ha of notified forest land and 20.112 ha of Revenue forest land.

Village wise details of forest land and Revenue forest land is given below:-

However out of 20.112 ha Revenue forest land 3.478 ha land has been settled and converted in to tenancy land. So far FRA is concerned as per clause 3 (e) of the Gazette Notification dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 2014, the DC, Singrauli has been issued the FRA certificate dated 27<sup>th</sup> March 2016. DC, Singrauli has issued the FRA Certificate for entire forest land including revenue forest land. The prospecting of mineral has been done way back when permission was not required under Forest Conservation Act 1980.

As per directive of Ministry of Coal, Govt. Of India, the mining plan has been formulated by CMPDL, Ranchi, a subsidiary of Coal India Limited and approval of mining plan has been done by NCL Board. Copy of same are uploaded online.

Regarding R&R plan and scheme of the project, this is to state that NCL is a govt. of India undertaking under Ministry of Coal, Govt. Of India. The mining plan/ Project Report of its mines are prepared by another Govt. Of India company – CMPDIL and is approved by Board of Directors of NCL. Since in this project no displacement of people will take place so R&R is not required. However if any displacement take place in future then the rehabilitation of project affected person is based upon the R&R policy of CIL .
