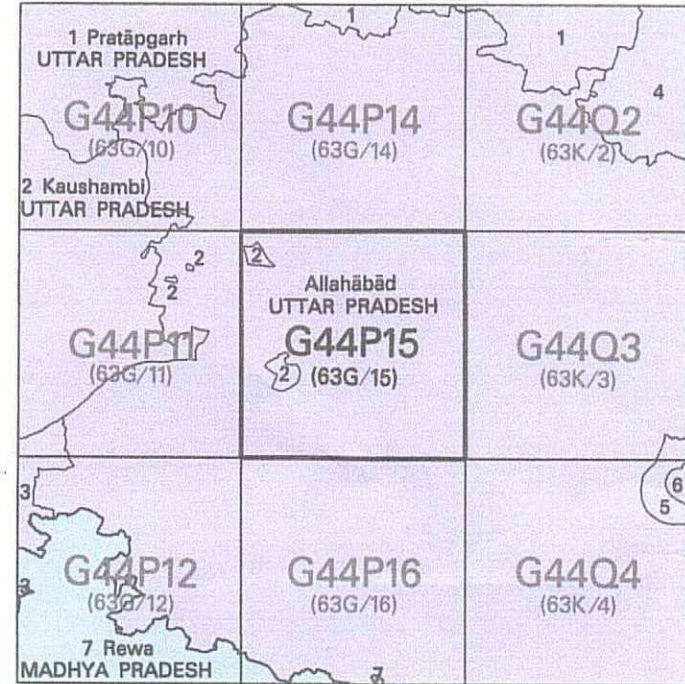

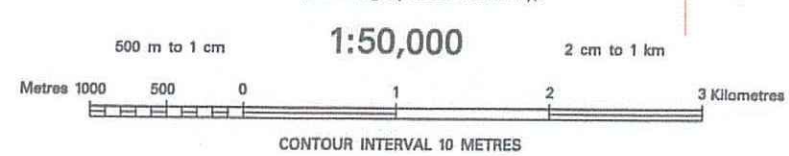
Notes:
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
The triangulated & traverse heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks, and may not be exactly in accordance with them.
A relative height, h_r , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December.
The kilometre scale numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in black type, e.g. 5, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 5.1.
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along roads is required from the village authorities.
The areas adjoining the Ganga and Yamuna Rivers are liable to change owing to continual fluctuations in the course of these rivers.
A relative height, h_r , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
