## CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. This consent is valid only for the approved production capacity of Alcohol- 90 KL/Day.

- 2. The equipment for air pollution control system and monitoring, as proposed by the industry and approved by the Board should be installed in their premises itself.
- 3. Industry shall dispose the incineration boiler ash in such a manner so that there should not be any adverse impact on public health at large and on Soil, Water & Air environment.
- 4. The modification or installation in the existing pollution control equipment shall be done only by prior approval of the Board.
- 5. The operation of air pollution control system and maintenance be done in such a way that the quantity of pollutants shall be in accordance with the standards prescribed by the Board/MoEF& CC/or otherwise mandatory.
- 6. Unit shall do provisions for control of fugitive emissions from process as per the norms of the Board/MOEF & CC/or otherwise mandatory.
- 7. The unit shall submit the stack emissions monitoring report within one month from issuance of consent order along with the point wise compliance report of the consent order. Further quarterly monitoring report analysed by Board/NABL accredited laboratory shall be submitted.
- 8. In case of closure directions under section-5 of E (P) Act, 1986 issued by CPCB, this consent will be automatically suspended during the closure period, and will be automatically reinstated with specific conditions as per CPCB revocation orders.
- 9. Industry shall develop and maintain green belt as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide office order dated 16/02/2018, which is available on Board's Website- www.uppcb.com.
- 10. Industry shall submit Environment Statement to this Board as per provision of Environment (Protection) amendment Rule, 1993 for the previous year ending 31st March on or before 30th September every year.
- 11. Industry shall abide by orders / directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme court, Hon'ble High Court, Hon'ble National Green tribunal, Central Pollution Control Board and U.P Pollution Control Board for protection and safe guard of environment from time to time.

Authorised Signatory

1. Industry shall maintain and operate APCs to ensure the compliance of standard applicable, regarding SOx, NOx and SPM and will store fuel in a such way that it could not create any nuisance in the environment as well as outside premise.

2. Industry shall submit the calibration certification of online continues emission system at every 03

Month.

3. Industry shall ensure proper disposal of ash, so that it could not create any adverse impact in the environment.

4. The industry shall be operated in such a way that there is no harm to the nearby environment.

5. If any closure direction is issued against the industry, by CPCB/UPPCB the consent shall automatically remain suspended for that period and after ensuring compliance and after the closure order is revoked the consent.

6. The directions issued by the Hon'ble NGT / Court / CPCB / UPPCB shall be completely complied. 7. A thick green belt of trees of suitable species able to attain 8-10 metre height on maturity shall be developed in multi lineate staggered manner on a minimum 33% of the land on which the industry is established. as per the "Protocol for Development of Green Belt" notified vide Board Office Order No.H16405/220/2018/02 dated.16.02.2018 in this regard and available at URL http://www.uppcb.com/pdf/Green-belt-Guidle-\_160218.pdf.

8. Any source of emission other than that mentioned in the Air consent seeking application will not

be permitted by the Board.

9. Industry shall submit Environmental Statement in prescribed format in Form V of rule 14 of E.P. Rules 1986.

10. This consent is valid only for products and quantity mentioned above. Industry shall obtain prior approval before making any modification in product/process /fuel / plant machinery failing which consent would be deemed void.

11. Industry shall submit quarterly monitoring reports of all stacks and ambient air quality from a

certified / approved laboratory under E.P. Act 1986.

12. This consent is valid for production for 350 days per annum in compliance of CPCB office memorandum dated 25.03.2019.

12. Industry shall comply with various provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 as amended, Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 as amended and all other applicable rules notified under E.P. Act 1986.

13. The unit shall submit the audited balance sheet for the current year and the details of fees

deposited during last three years within a month.

14. Industry shall ensure proper Air and Noise pollution control system with installed D.G. Sets.
