Sub:- Transfer of roadside plantation along P.W.D. roads to the Forest Department.

I am directed to say that the question of transfer of road side plantation along P.W.D. roads to the Forest Deptt. has been under the consideration of Govt. for some time past. It has now been decided that the work of roadside plantation and maintenance of roadside avenue along P.W.D. roads should be transferred to the Forest Deptt. subject to the following conditions :-

- 1) Roadside plantations and avenue will be transferred from the P.W.D. to the Forest Deptt. in accordance with a phased programme to be worked out between the Chief Engineer and the Chief Conservator of Forests.
- 2) A list of selected species of trees to be planted along the P.W.D. roads will be prepared jointly by the CCF. and Chief Engineer, P.W.D. in selecting trees for plantation preference will be given to trees which provide shades.
- 3) To ensure an uninterrupted flow of traffic and also to ensure an unhindered view of the road ahead, ever hanging branches of trees over roadside paths shall be chopped off by the Forest Deptt. so as to provide a clearance of at least 16' from the road surface. (At present the required clearance is 14' the rules will be revised to provide for a clearance of 16')
- 4) In case where P.W.D. Officers give notice of ever hanging branches to the P.W.D. concerned, Forest Deptt. will ensure the cutting down of the ever hanging branches upto the required clearance. If, however the Forest Deptt. fails to do so, the P.W.D. would be entitled to effect the necessary cutting.
- 5) Forest Deptt. will ensure the prompt removal of fallen trees which hinder of obstruct traffic. If much fallen trees are not removed promptly by Forest Deptt. , P.W.D. would be entitled to remove them under intimation to the Forest Deptt.
- 6) Before finalising any list of trees to be felled or sold by Public auction, Forest Deptt. would furnish it to the Engineer concerned. If the P.W.D. Engineer objected to the cutting of the any green tree in any reach, the list would be modified accordingly. The sale list would be finalized by the Forest Deptt. only the views of the P.W.D. have been considered.
- 7) Forest Deptt. will meet the fuel and other wood requirements of the P.W.D. for carrying out its road construction and road repairing operations.
- 8) Forest Deptt. will give preference for purposes of employment in the Forest Deptt. to the mallas and aches at present employed in the P.W.D. for maintenance of roadside avenue who would be surplus to the requirements of P.W.D.
- 9) The Forest Deptt. will frame new rules and revenue existing rules for the proper managements of the roadside avenues on the lines indicated above in consultation with the P.W.D.

2. I am to request that necessary steps may kindly be taken to implement the above decisions of Govt. and Govt. informed of the action taken in the matter.

3. Necessary funds for the roadside plantation and maintenance of roadside avenue after they have been handed over to the Forest Deptt. will be arranged by that Deptt. from its own budget.
