TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA) for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 5.5 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of linear Works Department, Circle Bhihiwara for construction of road at village Bijoliya to Chattrikhera via mangarh(Village-Thadooda,Mangarh,Patyal and Chhatri Kheta) Bijoliya Sub-Divisional issued by FRA certificate letter dated 02/08/2016.

Now Executive Engineer PWD PMGSY WB Div. Shahpura, Bhihiwara requested vide their letter dated 07/06/2018 that diversion of forest land is required 4.1 hectares instead of 5.5 hectares.

So through an Amendment in FRA certificate No F39-7(1)(RA/2014/3994 dated 02/08/2016, it is certified that 4.1 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Public Works Department, Circle Bhihiwara for construction of road at ~~Bijoliya~~ to Chattrikhera ~~Kheta~~ in Bijoliya Sub-Divisional.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 5.5 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meeting of the Forest Rights Committee, Gram Sabha, Sub-division Level Committee and the District Level Committee (enclosed as annexure -1 to annexure - 4), further Executive Engineer PWD PMGSY WB Div. Shahpura, Bhihiwara requested vide their letter dated 07/06/2018 that diversion of forest land is required 4.1 hectares instead of 5.5 hectares.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and Gram Sabha has given their consent to it;
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.
