



Undertaking for submission of Soil Conservation and Moisture Plan (SCMP).

It is to certify that I, Ashish Rana, Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti Division Nahan, District Sirmour HP have applied for the diversion of 2.1379 ha. of Forest land for construction of Sewerage Treatment Plants for proposed construction of providing sewerage scheme to Nahan town.

In accordance with the directions issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MOFEC) vide letter No. 7th June, I, Ashish Rana, Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti Division Nahan do hereby solemnly undertake to submit Soil and Moisture Conservation Plan along with Stage-I compliance in aforementioned Forest case.

However, if the preparation of Plan is delayed and it is not possible for the State Govt. to submit the compliance, then Jal Shakti Vibhag (User agency) shall submit lump sum of cost **0.05%** of the project i.e **72,15,174.63** **(The total cost of the project amounting to Rs. 1,44,30,34,926/-)** along with the stage-I compliance for obtaining stage-II approval subject to availability of funds. The deficit amount, as per the above said plan, if any from the money already realized to the tune of 0.5% of project cost shall be deposited by Jal Shakti Vibhag in the CAMPA account prior to actual working on the forest area.


