NOTIFICATION

The Right Honourable the Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from the 15th October, 1901, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification, shall be constituted a "reserved forest"

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BOUNDARIES

North:-- Starting from the south-west corner of survey No.216 (Pillapayer river) of Gandipalem on the village boundary between Gandipalem and Chavudopalli (Kalahasti Zamindari), the line runs along the south side of that number up to the western-most corner of survey No.232; then the south-west side of that number, the south and east sides of survey No.231 and the east side of survey No.230 up to its north-east corner; then along the south side of survey No.216 up to the north-west corner of survey No.217; then the west and south sides of that number up to its south-east corner; then a straight line to the south-west corner of survey No.221; then the south side of that number up to its south-east corner (all the above numbers are of Gandipalem); then a straight line south-east to cairn No.1 at the south-west corner of survey No.397-17; then the south side of that number up to cairn No.2 at its southernmost corner; then a straight line east-south-east to cairn No.3 at the southernmost corner of K. Kalaiaya's Sivayijamma cultivation; then east-north-east for about two and a half chains to cairn No.4 at the south-east corner of the said cultivation; then a straight line north-east for about thirty-five chains to cairn No.5. at the south-west corner of Balireddi and Nayaiya's sivayijamma cultivation; then along the south side of that cultivation first for a distance of four and half chains to cairn No.6 and then for about ten and a half chains to cairn No.7 at the south-east corner of the said cultivation; then a straight line due east for about five chains to cairn No.8 on the south bank of the Pillapayer river; then along the south bank of the river up to where it crosses the west side of survey No.609 of Guvvadi.

East:-- Then the west sides of survey Nos.609, 608 and 606 up to the south-west corner of the last number.

South:-- Then the north and west sides of survey No.549 up to the north-east corner of survey No.548; then the north and west sides of that number and the west side of survey No.547 up to the north-east corner of survey No.401; then the north sides of survey Nos.401 and 400, the east and north sides of survey No.398, the east and north sides of survey No.418, the north and west sides of survey No.419, and the west sides of survey Nos.420, 422, 423, 424 and 426 up to the south-west corner of last number; then the north side of survey No.411, the north and west sides of survey No.428 and the west sides of survey Nos.429, 440 and 441 (all of Guvvadi) to the south-west corner of the last field, a point on the village boundary between Guvvadi and Gulinarava; then westwards along that

South:--(continued):-- village boundary up to where it turns north-west.

West:--Then along the same village boundary to cairn No.9 about twenty-one and a half chains south-west of the southernmost corner of survey No.229 of Gandipalem (inside the reserve); then a straight line north-west to cairn No.10, a point on the boundary between Chavudepalli and Gandipalem villages about twenty four and a half chains west-south-west of the southernmost corner of survey No.229 of Gandipalem; then along the surveyed and mapped boundary between Chavudepalli and Gandipalem to the starting point.

The following public rights of way have been admitted:--

I. i. The cart-track, five yards wide from Gandipalem to Kondareddipalli:-- This enters the reserve about eleven chains north-west of the north-west corner of survey No.217 of Gandipalem and running south-south-east for about one mile and six and a quarter furlongs, leaves it about three and a half chains south of the north-west corner of survey No.428 of Guvvadi.

ii. The cart-track, three yards wide, from Isakapalli to Kondareddipalli:-- This enters the reserve about three chains north-east of cairn No.4 and running south for about three and three-fourth furlongs, leaves it about one and a half chains east of the north-east corner of survey No.401 of Guvvadi.

iii. The foot-path, two yards wide for men only, from Iskapalem to Tirumalapuram:-- This branches from No. ii supra at its point of entrance into the reserve and running south-east for about one mile and a half furlong, leaves it about five chains west of the north-east corner of survey No.401. of Guvvadi.

iv. The cart-track, five yards wide, from Guvvadi to Kondareddipalli:--This enters the reserve about twenty-eight chains north-west of the north-east corner of the reserve and running south-west for about seven furlongs, leaves it at the north-east corner of survey No.401 of Guvvadi.

V. The Cart-track, five yards wide, from Guvvadi to Udayagiri:--This enters the reserve about fourteen chains north-west of the north-east corner of the reserve and running south for about one and three-fourth furlongs, leaves it at the north-west corner of survey No.401 of Guvvadi.

Vi. The foot-path, two yards wide for men only, from Chavudepalli to Kondareddipalli:--This enters the reserve about one and a half chains north of cairn No.13 and running south-east for about one mile and half a furlong, joins the cart-track No. i. supra about five chains from its point of exit.

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II. The following fields of the Gandipalem village have been ordered to be demarcated out and retained as enclosures within the reserve free from reservation with access by the cart-track No.I.i. supra:--
