No.133.--In Exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (Madras Act V of 1882), the Government of Madras are hereby pleased to declare that the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule below, shall be constituted reserved forest with effect on and from 15th February 1939:--

SCHEDULE

Vizagapatam district, Gudem taluk.

(Name of reserved forest--Bointi reserved forest - Area --  
43,028 acres).

BOUNDARIES.

North:- Starting from cairn No.1 a point at a distance of 1,584 links and at a bearing of 160 degrees from Bonangi metta the boundary runs with the following bearings and distances:--

NOTE:- Station No.1 starts from the 6th Khandam station on the eastern boundary line of the reserve counted from the trijunction stone between No.33 Antada and No.32. Kothapalli villages.

II The following rights of ways are admitted within the reserve to a width of 10 yards:--

R.W.I JOGAMPETA-NALLAKONDA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 90 links north of cairn No.196 runs generally north-east and south-east for a distance of 2 miles, 1 furlong, 4 chains, 38 links and leaves the reserve on its eastern boundary at cairn No.150.

R.W.II PIDATAMAMIDI-NALLAKONDA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to



men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at the fourth khandam stone counted from the trijunction stone between No.19 Goddapalli and No.20. Pidatamamidi villages, runs generally east-south-east for a distance of 3 miles, 3 furlongs, 5 chains, 71 links and joins the right of way No.1 at a point which is 34.75 chains north-west of its exit at cairn No.150.

R.W.III KOTHAPALLI-NIMMALAGONDI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at the 36th Khandam stone counted from the trijunction stone (at the north-east corner of Kothapalli village) between No.33. Antada and No.32, Kothapalli villages, runs generally north-west for a distance of 1 mile, 6 furlongs 7 chains, 61 links and leaves the reserve at a point 138 links north of cairn No.38 of No.7, Nimmalagondi enclosure.

R.W.IV. BUDARALLA-NIMMALAGONDI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 1,220 links north of cairn No. 247, runs generally east-south-east for a distance of 1 mile, 8 chains, 17 links and leaves the reserve at a point 200 links north of cairn No.58 of No.7 Nimmalagondi enclosure.

R.W. V. TENKALAPANUKU-KOKULURU FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve at cairn No.12 of No.7. Tenkalapanuku enclosure, runs generally north-east for a distance of 5 furlongs 6 chains and leaves the reserve at a point 90 links north of cairn No.87 of the No. 6 Dokuluru enclosure.

R.W. VI. KOTHAPALLI-TENKALAPANUKU FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 515 links west of 23rd khandam stone counted from the trijunction stone (at the north-east corner of Kothapalli village) between village No.32, Kothapalli and No.33. Antada village runs generally north, and north-west for a distance of 3 miles, 3 furlongs, 8 chains, 14 links and leaves the reserve at a point 355 links south-west of cairn No.19 of No.7. Tenkalapanuku enclosure.

R.W. VII. MULASALA-KOMALAGONDI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at the sixth khandam stone counted from the trijunction stone (at the north-east corner of Kothapalli village) between No.32. Kothapalli and No.33 Antada village runs generally north-east, north-north-westerly directions for a distance of 3 furlongs, 8 chains and leaves the reserve at cairn No.14 of No.9. Domalagondi enclosure.

R.W. VIII. ANTADA-SINGADHARA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at the tenth khandam stone, counted from the trijunction stone between No.33. Antada and No.34. Balusutakurapakalu villages, runs generally north-west for a distance of 5 furlongs, 8 chains, 83 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.25 of No.8. Singadhara enclosure.

R.W.IX. KOKKITAPADU-YEDDUMAMIDI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve from No.6. Kokkitapadu enclosure boundary at a point 388 links



south-west of cairn No.80 runs generally south-east for a distance of 2 miles, 2 furlongs, 5 chains and leaves the reserve at a point 117 links north-east of cairn No.42 of No.8 Yeddumamidi enclosure.

R.W. X. KATRAGADDA-RAMPULU BRIDLEPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 502 links north-east of third khandam stone counted from the trijunction stone between No.42, Katragadda and No.43. Ganarlapalem villages, runs generally west, north-west for a distance of 3 miles, 5 furlongs, 7 chains, 80 links and leaves the reserve at a point 175 links south of cairn No.56 of No.6 Rampulu enclosure.

R.W. XI. TEGALAMETTA-RAMPULU BRIDLEPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at trijunction stone between Tegalametta (mokhasa) and No.44. Gambkonda villages, runs west for a distance of 2 miles, 5 furlongs, 5 chains, 43 links and leaves the reserve at a point 310 links north of cairn No.52 of No.6 Rampulu enclosure.

R.W.XII PEDDAVALASA-CHAPARATIPALEM BRIDLEPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 150 links north-east of cairn No.283, runs generally south-east for a distance of 5 furlongs, 6 chains and leaves the reserve at cairn No.3 of No.6. Chaparatipalem enclosure.

R.W.XIII CHAPARATIPALEM-VASUVADA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve at cairn No.19 of No.6 Chaparatipalem enclosure, runs generally north, north-west for a distance of 7 furlongs, 4 chains 10 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.45 of No.5 Vasuvada enclosure.

R.W. XIV NIMMALPALEM - VASUVADA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 1,220 links north-east of cairn No.303, runs generally south-east for a distance of 3 furlongs, 3 chains, 85 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.55 of No.5 Vasuvada enclosure.

R.W. XV RAMPULU-SINGANAPALLI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve at cairn No.40 of No.6. Rampulu enclosure, runs north-west, south-west and north-east for a distance of 3 miles, 5 furlongs, 7 chains, 49 links and leaves the reserve at a point 250 links north of cairn No.150 of No.1. Singanapalli enclosure.

R.W. XVI GANDEMPALLI-SINGANAPALLI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 1,560 links north of cairn No.319, runs generally east for a distance of 4 furlongs, 6 chains and leaves the reserve at a point 500 links north-east of cairn No.157 of No.1. Singanapalli enclosure.

R.W. XVII ANTARLA-LINGAVARAM FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its northern boundary at a point 1,600 links south-east of cairn No.11, runs generally south-east for a distance of 1 mile,



9 chains and 30 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No. 29 of No.1 Lingavaram enclosure.

R.W. XVIII. KOLAPARI-MADAM FOOTPATH.-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its northern boundary at a point 460 links east of cairn No.57, runs generally south-west for a distance of 1 mile, 3 furlongs, 9 chains, 45 links and leaves the reserve at a point 46 links south-east of cairn No.55 of No.1 Madam enclosure.

R.W. XIX RAVIRINTADA-SALLAI FOOTPATH:- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its northern boundary at cairn No.76, runs generally south-west for a distance of 3 furlongs, 1 chain, 30 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.20 of No.2. Sallai enclosure.

R.W. XX KOMMANGI-SALLAI FOOTPATH:- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 200 links south of cairn No.108 runs generally north-west for a distance of 5 furlongs 9 chains, 88 links and leaves the reserve at a point 744 links south of cairn No.23 of No.2, Sallai enclosure.

R.W. XXI. SARAMANDA-NAGULAGONDI FOOTPATH:- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve at cairn No.7 of No.3 Saramanda enclosure, runs generally north for a distance of 4 furlongs, 9 chains 65 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.43 of No.2. Nagulagondi enclosure.

R.W. XXII. BENNAVARAM-SARAMANDA FOOTPATH:- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point where Saramandakaluva cuts the boundary, runs generally north for a distance of 6 furlongs, 5 chains, 30 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.32 of No.3. Saramanda enclosure.

R.W. XIII. BENNAVARAM-DAMANAPALLI FOOTPATH:- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 25.00 chains south-west of trijunction stone between No.48. Bennavaram and No.46. Bangarupalem villages, runs generally north-west for a distance of 2 miles, 8 chains, 15 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.124 of No.1. Damnapalli enclosure.

R.W. XXIV KRISHNADEVIPETA-KOYYURU PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT ROAD:- 30 feet wide, open to men, cattle and vehicles. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 2 chains north-west of cairn No.5 of Saruguda reserved forest Block No.VI, runs south-west for a distance of 17.20 chains and meets the common boundary line between Saruguda reserved forest Block No.VI and Bointi reserved forest at a point 5.18 chains south-west from cairn No.4 of Saruguda reserved forest Block No.VI, thence it runs south-west along the said common boundary line for a distance of 6.00 chains (this distance forms part of right of way No. IV within Saruguda Block No.VI. Reserved Forest) and leaves the reserve at a point 11.18 chains to the south-west of cairn No.4 of Saruguda reserved forest Block No.VI. It re-enters the reserve on its southern boundary at a point 8.02 chains north-east from cairn No.2 of Saruguda reserved forest Block No.VI and runs generally in a north-west and south-westerly direction for a distance of 50.90 chains and finally quits the reserve at the trijunction of Chintapapudi village and Saruguda Block No.VI and Bointi



reserved forests (a point 6 chains north-east from cairn No.1 of Sarugudu reserved forest Block No.VI). The total distance of the road within the reserve is 6 furlongs, 8 chains and 10 links.

NOTE:- The Public Works Department is permitted to do all acts necessary for the repairs, and maintenance of the road within a width of one chain on either side from the centre of the road but not entitled to the tree growth thereon.

III Right of repair Kattakalva starting from the junction of Ullabogulamamidi and Tegalapanakulu kalva and to use the water for irrigation. The channel runs in a south-easterly direction over a length of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  furlongs in the reserve till it crosses the reserved forest boundary near the third khandam stone counting from the trijunction stone between Kamparegula, Bangarapalem villages and Bointi reserved forest. The right granted on behalf of Panasala Lakshmana Padal of Kamparegulu (Movilidoddi) villages. The repairs permitted will be reclearance of growth on the side of the kalva and removal of obstructions caused by refuse material accumulating in the kalva and its subject to the condition that the repairs are not to be carried out so as to damage the forest.

IV. Right to irrigate from the channel Gunaparayi Pumarayi and repair the channel which starts at a point which is at a distance of three furlongs up the Gankonda loudi stream from the reserve line and runs eastwards for about a mile in the reserve and quits it near the trijunction stone between Kamparegulu, Gankonda villages and Bointi reserved forest. The right is granted on behalf of Murla Chitikalayya of Gankonda village. The repairs permitted will be reclearance of growth on the side of the kalva and removal of obstructions caused by refuse material accumulating in the kalva and is subject to the condition that the repairs are not to be carried out so as to damage the forest.

V. Right to continue the diversion of water at Pantapadu by a dam for cultivation of the lands is admitted on behalf of Kavadam Burrayya Phora. The easement admitted is as follows:--

Kavadam Barrayyadora to have the right of maintaining the dam of a height from the stream bed not exceeding 6 feet and a breadth not exceeding 6 yards. To excavate from the streams earth only for the formation of the dam. To enter and quit the reserve by the stream bed, for the purpose of visiting such dam as he may have to continue to maintain. To have right also to enter the reserve by the irrigation channel for the purpose of repairing or removing obstructions from such channel.
