

NOTIFICATION

Fort St. George, September 28, 1936

No.490.-- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), the Governor in Council is hereby pleased to direct that with effect on and from 21st December 1936, the area; the boundaries of which are described in the schedule below shall be constituted a "Reserved Forest" under the said Act.

SCHEDULE.

Vizagapatam district, Gudem taluk.

(Name of the Reserved Forest --Wangasari. Area--8,551 acres)

BOUNDARIES

North:- Starting from cairn No.1, a point on the left bank of Cherapalli stream, at a distance of 2,050 links and at a bearing of 39° from the summit of Nakkalametta (outside the block) and also at a distance of 2,080 links and at a bearing of 301° from another summit of Nakkalametta (within the block), down the left bank of Cherapalli stream for a distance of 8,473 links to cairn No.2, a point on the left bank of Cherapalli stream at a distance of 10.88 chains and at a bearing of 117° from the southern peak of Kuthurupitta metta; thence with the following bearings and distances:--

REMARKS.-- Cairn No.22 is a point on the right bank of Peddagedda at a distance of 20.85 chains and at a bearing of 240° from the south-western summit of Andhulamma Metta hill. Thence down the right bank of Peddagedda for a distance of 53.02 chains to cairn No.23, a point at a distance of 23.45 chains and at a bearing of 342° from the northern summit of Andhulamma Metta Hill.

REMARKS:- Station No.1 of the connecting line starts a point on reserve boundary lines at a distance of 850 links south-east of cairn No.125.

B. The following rights of way are admitted within the reserve to a width of ten yards in each case:--

(1) LAMMASINGI-LOTUGEDDA ROAD:-- This is open to men, cattle and vehicles. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at cairn No.105, runs generally in a northern direction for a distance of 3 miles 1 furlong 7 chains and 54 links and leaves the reserve at cairn No.57; it re-enters the reserve at cairn No.55, runs generally north and then west for a distance of 7 furlongs 5 chains 39 links and finally leaves the reserve at cairn No.19 on its northern boundary. The total distance of this road within the reserve is 4 miles 1 furlong 2 chains and 93 links.

NOTE:- The Public Works Department is permitted to do all acts necessary for the repairs and maintenance of the road within a width of one chain on either side from the centre of the road but not entitled to the tree growth thereon.

(2) CHINTAPALLI-LOTUGEDDA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 400 links north-west of cairn No.262, runs generally north-east for a distance of 4 furlongs 7 chains and leaves the reserve on the left bank of the Cherapalli stream at a point 4,666 links from cairn No.1.

(3) WAMGEDDA-CHERUKUMPAKALA FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 75 links west of cairn No.258, runs generally north-east for a distance of 6 furlongs 1 chain and leaves the reserve on the left bank of the Cherapalli stream at a point 758 links west of cairn No.2. Again it enters the reserve at a point 15 links west north of cairn No.4, runs generally north-east for a distance of 2 furlongs 1 chain and leaves the reserve at a point 1,140 links south-east of cairn No.11. The total distance of this path within the reserve is 1 mile and 2 chains.

(4) JANNULU-KOTHAPALEM FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 200 links north-east of cairn No.76 runs generally south-east for a distance of 4 furlongs 5 chains and leaves the reserve at a point 500 links south-east of cairn No.81.

(5) WAMGEDDA-ANDRUDOBBI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its western boundary at a point 640 links north-east of cairn No.245, runs generally eastwards for a distance of 1 mile 4 furlongs and 4 chains and meets (right of way No.1) the Lammasingi-Lotugedda road near 28th mile 7th furlong stone.

(6) KINVERA-WANGASARI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve on its eastern boundary at a point 850 links south-east of cairn No. 125, runs generally south-west for a distance of 3 furlongs 4 chains and leaves the reserve at a point 13 links south-east of cairn No.12 of the Wangasari enclosure.

(7) WANGASARI-CHINTAPALLI FOOTPATH:-- This is open to men and cattle. It enters the reserve at cairn No.26 of the Wangasari enclosure, runs generally south-west for a distance of 4 furlongs 2 chains and 10 links and leaves the reserve on its southern boundary at a point 263 links west of cairn No.167.
