**PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE
ANDHRA PRADESH FOREST ACT, 1967 IN RES-
PECT OF KRISHNAPURAM FOREST BLOCK
PROPOSED TO BE RESERVED IN PADERU
TALUK VISAKHAPATNAM DISTRICT.**

Whereas by a notification under section 4 of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Act 1967 published at pages from 811 to 828 of Part I of *Andhra Pradesh Gazette*, dated 16th May 1968 it is proposed to form into a reserved forest all the block of land comprised within the following limits as per Schedule, it is hereby notified, for general information that during the interval between the date of the said notification and the date fixed by the Notification under section 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Act of 1967, hereafter to be published by the Government declaring the said land to be a Reserved Forest: (i) no right shall be acquired by any person in or over the land included in the Notification under Section 4 except by succession or under a grant or contract in writing made or entered into by or on behalf of the Government or any person in whom such right was vested before the publication of the Notification under section 4; (ii) no new house shall be built or plantation formed; no fresh clearing for cultivation or for any other purpose shall be made, on such land and no trees shall be cut from such land for the purpose of trade or manufacture provided that nothing shall prohibit the doing of any act specified in this clause with the permission in writing of the Forest Settlement Officer; and, (3) no person shall set fire or kindle or leave burning any fire in such manner as to endanger or damage such land or forest produce. (4) No patta in such land shall be granted by or on behalf of the Government. All persons, therefore claiming any rights in any of the said lands or to any of the forest produce thereof are hereby required to state to the undersigned either personally or orally or by written statement within six months from

the date of publication of this Proclamation in the District Gazette, the nature of the rights claimed and to produce all documents they possess in support of such claims.

All rights in respect of which no claims are preferred within the above stated period will, after the lands have been declared by Notification in the *Andhra Pradesh Gazette* under Section 15 to be a Reserved Forest, become extinguished.

Rights of ways to be admitted in the block at a width of 12 feet for men and cattle.

1. Foot path from Pedapadu to Konthalam. Foot path from Pedapadu to Konthalam entering the proposed block just by the side of the station No. 70 and runs generally in a south westerly direction through the block over a distance of about 1 mile and 2 furlongs and leaves the block between station 840 and 841 at a distance of 380 links from station 840 is to be admitted.

2. Foot-path from Boddagondi to Kurupadu. Foot-path from Boddagondi to Kurupadu entering the proposed block between stations 98 and 99 at a distance of 570 links from station No. 98 and runs generally in an easterly direction through the block over a distance of about 7 furlongs and leaves the block just by the side of station No. 176 is to be admitted.

3. Foot-path from Vullivaripadu to Kokatipadu enclosure.—One foot-path from Vullivaripadu to Kokatipadu enclosure entering the proposed block

just by the side of a station No. 279 and runs generally in a westerly direction through the block over a distance of about 4 furlongs and 877 links and enters the Kokatipadu enclosure just by the side of station No. 10 of Kokatipadu enclosure is to be admitted.

4. Foot-path from Gemili to Barasingimetta (via) (Gemili wet land).

One foot-path from Gemili to Barasingimetta (via) Gemili wet lands enclosure entering the proposed block between stations 365 and 366 at a distance of 240 links from station No. 366 and runs generally in a southerly direction and thence south-easterly direction through the block over a distance of about 655 links and entering the Gemili wet lands enclosure just by the side of a station No. 6 and leaves the enclosure at a distance of 615 links from station No. 16 of the said enclosure and runs generally through the block over a distance of about 1 mile and leaves the block between stations 446 and 447 at a distance of 452 links from C. No. 446 is to be admitted.

5. Foot-path from Padmapuram and Pothadigondi enclosure.—One foot-path from Padmapuram to Pothadigondi enclosure entering the block just by the side of a station No. 567 and runs generally in a north-easterly direction through the block over a distance of about 4 furlongs and 47 links and enters the Pothadigondi enclosure at its station No. 14 is to be admitted.

6. Foot-path from Tokarayi to Pothadigondi enclosure.—One foot-path from Tokarayi to Pothadigondi enclosure entering the proposed block between stations 458 and 459 at a distance of 230 links from station No. 458 and runs generally in a south-westerly direction through the block over a distance of about 7 furlongs and enters the Pothadigondi enclosure just by the side of station No. 9 is to be admitted.

7. Mule-path from Tajang to Gangarajumadugula.—One mule-path from Tajangi to Gangarajumadugula entering the proposed block just by the side of station No. 600 and runs generally in a northerly and thence north-easterly direction through the block over a distance of about 1 mile and 3 furlongs and leaves the block just by the side of station No. 367 is to be admitted.

8. Foot-path from Devarapalli to Baliipeta enclosure.—One foot-path from Devarapalli to Baliipeta enclosure entering the proposed block just by the side of station No. 760 and runs generally in a north-easterly direction through the block over a distance of about 2 furlongs and enters the Baliipeta enclosure just by the side of station No. 49 of Baliipeta enclosure is to be admitted.

9. Foot-path from Kokatipadu enclosure to Baliipeta enclosure.—One foot-path from Kokatipadu enclosure to Baliipeta enclosure entering the proposed block just by the side of a station No. 28 of Kokatipadu enclosure and runs generally in a westerly direction through the block over a distance

of about 4 furlongs 703 links and enters the Balijipeta enclosure just by the side of station No. 26 of Balijipeta enclosure is to be admitted.

10. *Foot-path from Balijipeta enclosure to Thandipalem enclosure.*—One foot-path from Balijipeta enclosure to Thandipalem enclosure entering the proposed block just by the side of a station No. 131 of Balijipeta enclosure and runs generally in a southeasterly direction through the block over a distance of about 1 mile and 1 furlong 545 links and enters the Thandipalem enclosure just by the side of a station No. 1 of the Thandipalem enclosure is to be admitted.

11. *Foot-path from Campa to Geddarametta enclosure.*—One foot-path from Campa village runs west wards and enters the block by the side of the prismatic station No. 430 and runs in west and north-westerly direction through the block over a distance of 1 furlong and 700 links and enters Geddarametta enclosure by the side of prismatic station No. 4 of Geddarametta enclosure is to be admitted.
