## BRIEF NOTE

The Government of Goa has entrusted Goa State Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (GSIDC) with the construction of bridge across river Tiracol connecting Keri to Tiracol village. The said bridge was announced in the Budget Assurance 2012 – 2013.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 76.77 Crores and consists of construction of a cable stayed bridge with navigation span of 210 m. The total length of bridge including approaches is 705 m. The project is located in North Western tip of the State across the river Tiracol. The main purpose of the project is to enhance the connectivity of the tiny strip of land in Tiracol village with main land of the State of Goa as the surrounding land falls under the adjoining State of Maharashtra and to enhance Tourism activities, as the tip is exposed to the Arabian Sea.

The proposed bridge lies in Survey Nos. 110, 112/1(part), 112/2(part) in Keri village and Survey Nos. 14/1(part), 14/2(Part), 15/1 (Part) and 15/7 (Part) in Tiracol village.
