Sir ,

Kindly refer to your good office letter number referred above, the observation raised vide under reference have been attended the same and reply as under :-

1. The above proposal appeared in KML file from Channi bridge Elaka mata to Jalsu Jot upto the jurisdiction of Bharmour Forest Division of Chamba District Himachal Pradesh due to high altitude and no population whereas towards Holi (Bharmour) side there are villages with maximum population. The purpose of this road is to give direct passage to Distt. Chamba and Distt. Kangra. The proposed road will connect Utrala village near Baijnath town in Distt. Kangra with Holi sub Tehsil (Bharmour Tribal Area) of Chamba Distt. H.P and is at a distance of 72 K.M. from Distt. head quarter. The Chamba is situated at a distance upto Baijnath via Nurpur 233 K.M. as there is no connectivity from Baijnath to Holi (Bharmour) other than Nurpur road at present people have to travel more than 300 K.M. from Holi to Baijnath. The proposed Road will shorten the distance of existing road by about 223 K.M (upto Baijnath). It is clarified that Surahi Pass /Jalsu Jot means is name of PASS/JOT. The maximum populations are tribes who are migrated during winter season due to heavy snow fall from high hill to lower foot hill for their livelihood due to non availability of works in snowy season. Due to non existence of shortest route all perishable commodities of the area are getting deteriorated and farmer not getting true value of their produce. To avoid these conflicts shortest route is proposed in KML file is not showing any habitation along the alignment. The end point it will connect with another road proposed under jurisdiction of Palampur Forest Division (Kangra) under name C/O Road from Utrala to Surahi pass (Portion Baklood to Surahi) K.M 10/0 to 33/500 within jurisdiction of Palampur Forest Division Distt. Kangra Himachal Pradesh on line no FP/HP/Road /47951 /2020 already submitted for clearance.

3. Benefited villages not exists on KML file from starting point to end point there is no habitations due to high altitude along the proposed alignment whereas the villages towards the Holi side (Bharmour Tribal area) to be benefited by this proposed road, villages code issued from competent authority is also enclosed for ready reference
