

Conversion of 0.00597 ha Forest land for laying underground pipeline for irrigation of agricultural land in Village Loolbai and Bhadurgarh Jandian tehsil & district Bathinda from Canal Outlet No. 51500/R of Raike Feeder Canal (RHS) under Forest Division Bathinda

Detail Note of the Project

The Project is designed for irrigating the agricultural fields from canal water by Department of Soil and Water Conservation Punjab. The Conveyance of water using 600 mm RCC Pipes provide assured irrigation to the canal command area of Mogha No. 51500/R and helps in conserve water. The pipeline from Canal Outlet No. 51500/R is proposed to cross the protected forest area along the canal for 49 meter long. The trench required for laying of pipe (0.45 M Ø) is 1.22 M. wide. Hence total forest area required to be excavated is $49.00 \times 1.22 = 59.78$ Sq. M., which is unavoidable and no alternate route is available. The laying of project assists in irrigating the fields hence improving crop yield and sustainability of farmers.
