Application presented on 14.1.62, by M/s. Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd., for grant of a Mining Lease for iron over an area of 1553 acres (actual area comes to 1595 acres or 653.95 hectares) in Deonra, Sitali etc., villages in the district of Keonjhar.

Whereas M/s. Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd., have applied to the State Government in accordance with the Mineral Concession Rules, 1950, for grant of a Mining Lease by their application read above;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of which the mining lease has been applied for belongs to Government and the land is at their disposal;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid Certificate of approval from the State Government;

Whereas the applicant being a limited company is incorporated in India;

Whereas the Government of India have conveyed their approval to the grant of M.L. under Section 5(2) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and also in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Section 3(1) of the said Act, permit M/s. Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd., to acquire M.L. for iron over 1595 acres (653.95 hectares) in the district of Keonjhar, in excess of the maximum limit prescribed for M.L. in Section 3(1)(b) of the said Act.

Whereas the party was asked in Mining and Geology Department Letter No. 2216-MG, dated 26.2.58, to indicate their willingness to observe the laws and conditions under which the prospecting license was proposed to be considered for grant and

and the party in his letter No.7741/OMC/52, dated 26.2.63,
agreed to abide by these conditions;

And whereas the State Government are hereby
pleased to order that a Mining Lease in respect of the land
over 1595 acres or 633.95 hectares be granted to Messrs. Orissa
Mining Corporation Ltd., subject to the conditions laid down
in the State Government letter No.2216-MG, dated 25.2.63. The
party should comply with all the terms and conditions including
furnishing of a surveyed map and description within 3 months
from the date of this order to the Collector, Keonjhar.

(2) Collector, Keonjhar. On receipt of all documents in full compliance of the terms and conditions laid down in Government letter No.2216-MG, dt.25.2.63, he will please forward the same to Government with a report about the security deposit and any other matter which the Collector might consider necessary to bring to the notice of Government. The party may be allowed to enter the area for survey, mapping and demarcation through his own resources and it should be checked by the dolite traverse by the Government surveyor immediately.
