


MUCK DISPOSAL PLAN

PROPOSAL FOR DIVERSION OF 49.69 HA OF FOREST LAND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF 2-LANING WITH HARD SHOULDERS OF DEMWE-BRAHMAKUND ROAD FROM KM 0.00 TO KM 18.464 OF DEMWE-HAWAI ROAD ON EPC MODE IN LOHIT DISTRICT IN THE STATE OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH.

1. As such, the subject proposal has been prepared as per revised forest (Conservation) rule 2003 under forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for obtaining forest clearance from Govt. of India for diversion of forestland purpose from Km 0 to Km 18.464 for road Demwe-Brahmakund.
2. Approximately 23,159 cum of muck is to be disposed off per km. With this rate, for 18.464 km 4,27,607 cum of muck is to be disposed off. Out of this 20% of muck will be utilized for side filling and raising the level of the road in fill sections. Hence the quantity of unusable muck which is to be disposed off = 80 % of 4,27,607 = 3,42,085 cum. Out of this surplus quantity will be disposed off in dumping yards/muck disposal sites having area for 4,06,620 cum. Land acquisition is being done for these dumping areas. Dumping sites shall be stabilized with provision of retaining structures and plantation enclosed in this proposal. Locations of Muck Disposal sites totaling for 4,06,620 cum is marked on Topo sheet.
3. Location of Muck disposal area **8.41 Ha under USF** as Annexure is enclosed.




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
