**Sub:** Forest Clearance – Proposal for diversion of 0.138 ha of forest land in Kothamangalam Division for construction of Vellakayam Micro Hydro Electric Project (90 KW) – Submission of reply to clarifications sought – Reg.

With reference to the communication cited at Ref (4), the following clarifications are submitted for your kind consideration:

- The proposed project is a 90 KW Micro Hydel Project, categorized under run-of-the-river type. The forest area proposed for diversion is 0.138 ha, located at Vellalu near Vellakkayam in the Thodupuzha Reserve Forest, under the Mullaringad Range, Idukki District.
- 2. The project site is located in the Kothamangalam Thodu which originates from Venmani. The water from the Kothamangalam thodudrains in to Kaliyar stream after travelling a distance around 20 km and waters from Kaliyar stream further travels 12kms and joins the periyar river, and it is clarified that this is the first proposal on this stretch of the thodu. Importantly, there is no consumptive use of water envisaged during the operational phase.
- 3. Regarding the status of **CIA/CCS studies**, the following points are submitted:
  - **a**. As per the **Office Memorandum dated 28.05.2013** (Ref 5), the responsibility for conducting Carrying Capacity Studies (CCS) of river basins lies with the respective **State Governments**. A copy of the OM is appended as **Annexure-A**.

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- **b**. The OM also stipulates that "the process may be initiated in the next three months and completed within two years, after which CCS will be a pre-requisite for EC/FC clearances."
- c. A **preliminary report** titled "Room for River Periyar Basin" prepared by the Government of Kerala is attached as **Annexure-B**.
- d. The Government of Kerala has also issued G.O.(P) No. 25/2025/WRD dated 26.06.2025 concerning the Operational Framework for Integrated River Basin Conservation and Management(Annexure-C).
- e. Under Section 3 of the Kerala Irrigation and Water Conservation Act, 2003, all watercourses and their water are declared to be the property of the Government, with rights to conserve and regulate them for irrigation and electricity generation, subject to relevant provisions in the Kerala Panchayath Raj Act, 1994 and the Kerala Municipality Act, 1994.
- **f**. In line with **Section 218** of the Kerala Panchayath Raj Act, 1994, the **local Panchayat** has already issued a **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** for the project.
- **g.** The **MoEF&CC** communication dated December 2023 (Ref 6) explicitly mentions that in-principle approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 may be granted for the **first hydropower project in a river basin** without the requirement of CCS/CIS at that stage. A copy is enclosed as **Annexure-D**.
- h. The Minutes of the Environmental Appraisal Committee (EAC) meeting supporting the above decision are attached as Annexure-E&F(Agenda Item 1.13 & 2.5)
- 4. A **soft copy of the KML file** of the proposed diversion area has been appended and uploaded to the **Parivesh Portal** for reference.
- 5. It may further noted that this Project got allotment from the Government of Kerala under **own land category**during 2019 as per the Small Hydro Policy,2012 and submitted for Forest Clearance during 2021. Any further delay in obtaining forest clearance will lead to time and cost overrun of the project.(**Annexure G**).

In view of the above, it is submitted that the proposal may kindly be considered for Stage-I (In-Principle) Forest Clearance since the project is a micro hydro project which uses the water for non-consumptive use and the micro turbine works like a small pump, subject to the condition that, if required, a No Objection Certificate shall be obtained from the competent authority in relation to CIA/CCS studies of the Kothamangalam Thodu, a tributary of the Periyar River. The undersigned also undertakes to ensure that the proposal remains within the carrying capacity as recommended in the forthcoming CIA/CCS report at any stage of project implementation or operation.

In light of the commitments made by the User Agency and the details submitted, it is requested that the matter may kindly be forwarded to the **MoEF&CC** for early consideration and processing.
