In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests (Mo EF), Government of India's letter No 11-9/98-FC ipt dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (recognition of forest Right) Act 2006 (FRA short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect in liners protests, it is certified that 0.996 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of GHMC (Name of user agency) for "Widening the existing BT road including formation of road in the widened portion and laying of Plastic BT road from Vishwakarma Colony to Bachupally road through forest land in Ward No.129-Suraram, Gajularamaram Circle, GHMC" (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Medchal district falls within of Bachupally village in Quthbullapur tehsils.
