

JOINT SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A proposal has been submitted under the Indian Forest Conservation Act-1980 for use of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The subject envisages the use of forest land for **Construction of Water Supply Scheme (WSS)** at **Banjar Basli Bela Wussan by PHE (Jal Shakil) Rural Water Supply Division Ganderbal/Srinagar**. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by us on **18th March & 22nd April-2021**.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest land measuring **0.176 Hacs**. The land proposed by the User Agency is the barest minimum required for the project and also the area so proposed doesn't house any unique flora & fauna. The measurements and calculations of the site for forest area is as under :
