A	A Letter from the State Government certifying that complete process of identification and settlement of rights under the RoFR Act has been carried out for the entire Forest area proposed for diversion with a record of all full consultations and meetings held.	There are no claims received under section 3(1), 3(1) c and 4m (5) of RoFR Act proposed for diversion of 0.76 Ha in favour of the Executive Engineer(R&B), NH Division, Kadapa in compartment No 743 of Surabi RF of Kadapa division, Y.S.R District.
B	A letter from the state Government certifying that proposals for such diversions (with full details of the project and its implications, In vernacular/ Local languages) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forest dwellers, who are the eligible under the RoFR Act.	There is no forest Dwellers in the proposed area. Hence the question of placing the proposals before the Grama Sabha does not arise. However the Grama Panchayat has passed resolution stating that there is no objection for diversion of 0.76 Ha in favour of the Executive Engineer(R&B), NH Division, Kadapa in compartment No 743 of Surabi RF of Kadapa division, Y.S.R District.
C	A letter from each of the concerned Grama Sabhas indicating that all formalities / processes under the RoFR Act have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensatory and ameliorative measures if any having understood the purposes and details of proposed diversion.	There are no claims under RoFR Act with regard to the proposed area. Question of obtaining consent from the Grama Sabha does not arise under RoFR Act. However Grama Sabha was conducted at surabi Grama Panchayat and they have given written statement stating that they have no objections for grant of land in favour of the Executive Engineer(R&B), NH Division, Kadapa.
D	A letter from the state Government certifying that the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the RoFR Act have been completed and that the Gram Sabhas have consented to it.	Since there are no claims under RoFR Act with regard to the proposed area. However Grama Sabha was conducted and no objections were received.

E	A letter from the state Government certifying that the discussions and decisions on such proposals had placed only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of members of Grama Sabha present.	The Grama Sabha was conducted with the villagers of Surabi Panchayat of Chakrayapeta Mandal. The villagers have not raised any objections for objections for diversion of proposed site.
F	Obtaining the written consent or rejection of the Grama Sabha to the proposals.	The written consent of the Grama Sabha of Surabi village and panchayat is enclosed. The Grama Panchayat was also passed resolution of land in forest area.
G	A letter from the State Government certifying that the rights of primitive tribal groups and pre agricultural communities where applicable have been specifically safe guarded as per the section of 3 (1) (e) of the RoFR Act.	Since there is no primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities existing in the Proposed area for diversion of protection of rights of such groups will not arise.
H	Any other issues having bearing on operationalisation of the RoFR Act.	There are no other issues concerned with RoFR Act.


