Sir,

I am directed to refer to State PWD Memo No. 3808/NH dated 23.08.2016 forwarding therein the priority list of works under CRF for Punjab for sanction under CRF during current financial year and certificate furnished vide Memo No. 4638/NH dated 30.09.2016 and to convey the Administrative Approval of the President for an amount of Rs 2834.30 lakhs (Rupees twenty eight crore thirty four lakhs and thirty thousand only) for the work of upgradation of Patti Tarn Taran Road in Distt. Tarn Taran for a length of 18.75 km under MDR-62 category of road subject to satisfying the criteria required as per CRF Rules regarding length, category of the road, encumbrance free availability of land etc.

2. The above sanction is based on the applicable schedule rates, to meet the construction of work debitable to the allocation of the Government of Punjab under the Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules, 2014 published vide Gazette Notification No. GSR 531 (E) dated 24th July, 2014 and circulated vide this Ministry's letter No. NH-11011/2/2000-P&M (Pr.) dated 26th August, 2014.
3. State Government shall ensure that individual project is technically approved, financially sanctioned within a period of four months from the date of administrative approval of the work failing which the work shall be deemed to have been de-sanctioned unless revised administrative approval of the Government of India is obtained.
4. No excess cost beyond 10% of the amount administratively approved for the proposal shall be permissible and the excess, if any, shall be arranged by the State from their own resources. No revised estimate will be considered in this scheme.
5. The State Government shall adopt e-tendering system on mandatory basis for execution of the above work failing which the expenditure incurred on the work will not be reimbursed by the Ministry.
6. The display boards on development activities of the work shall be made as per guidelines issued vide Ministry's letter No. RW/NH-33044/10/2002-S&R-F dated 26th May, 2003.
