TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF 's letter dated 5th Feb-2013 where in MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of Linear projects, it is certified that 4.388 hectares of forest land in Sy no 32 of Siddankolla Village, Sy no 33 and 24 of Benkanwari Village, Sy no 16 of Huvinhalli Village and Sy No 116,122,127 of Ramatal Village in Hunagund Taluk , Bagalkot District proposed to be diverted in favour of KSHIP-II Belgaum, a Government of Karnataka undertaking for widening of road in Bagalkot District falls within jurisdiction of Siddankolla, Benkanwari, Huvinhalli, Ramatal village in Hunagund Taluk.

It is further certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of Rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4.388 hectares of forest land in Sy no 32 of Siddankolla Village, Sy no 33 and 24 of Benkanwari Village, Sy no 16 of Huvinhalli Village, Sy No 116,122,127 of Ramatal Village in Hunagund Taluk , Bagalkot District proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s) are enclosed.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c) The each concerned Gram Sabha (S) has certified that all formalities /processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Siddankolla, Benkanwari, Huvinhalli, Ramatal village is enclosed.
- d) The discussion and decision on such proposal had taken place only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of the member of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabha (s) has given their consent to it.
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA

- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabha (s) has given their consent to it.
