


## MUCK DISPOSAL PLAN

### PROPOSAL FOR DIVERSION OF ADDITIONAL FOREST LAND OF 7.33 HA. FOR IMPROVEMENT/UP GRADATION OF TRANS ARUNACHAL HIGHWAY (NH-52 B) FROM PASIGHAT-PANGIN ROAD (KM 0.000 TO KM 20.000) TO NHDL SPECIFICATION IN TIRAP DISTRICT OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH.

#### Terrain

1. The Western part of Arunachal Pradesh comprises the two district of East Siang. East Siang district is connected to Assam by NH-52 which connects NH-37 at Kaliabore in Assam while West Siang District has the only connectivity to the Country by NH-52B through Pangin and Pasighat. West Siang District leads to the China Boarder via Yingkiang which is also depend on the Pasighat-Pangin road proposed for forest clearance.
2. As such the subject proposal has been prepared as per revised forest (Conversation) rule 2003 under forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for obtaining forest clearance from Govt of India for diversion of forest land for Non forestry purpose for road stretch from Km 0.000 to Km 20.000of Pasighat-Pangin.The complete issues of the areas proposed for diversion along with violated area of 7.33 hectares of forest land have been discussed on 18<sup>th</sup> July'2017 in the REC meeting at Regional Office Shilllong and has been decided to submit online proposal for diversion of additional 7.33 hectares of forest land
