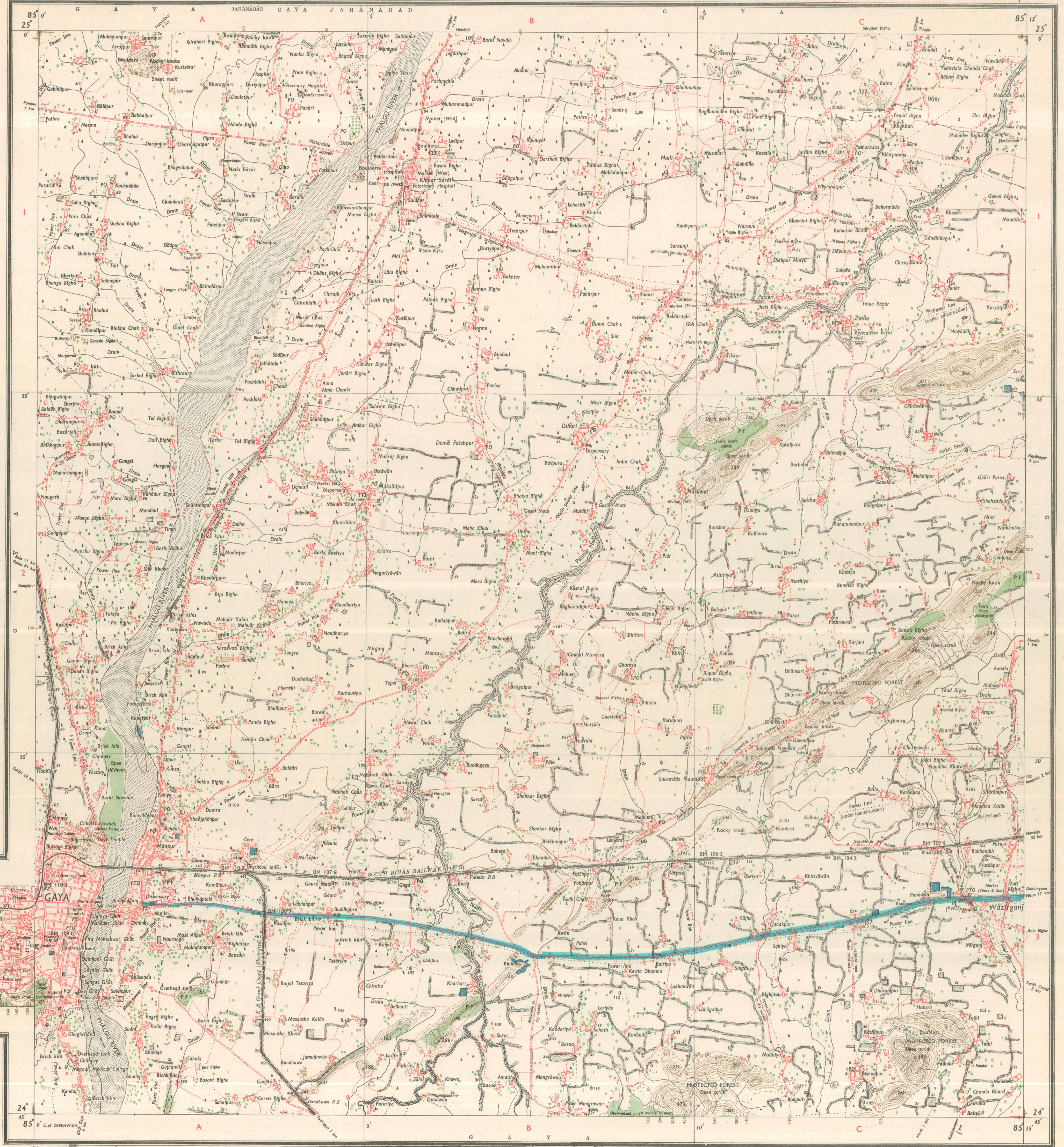

\*The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribbons.  
Contours are approximate.  
A relative height, *h*, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
Woods and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.  
\*Not applicable.

Forest boundaries are not demarcated but have been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground. Numerous fields/bands of less than 2 metres in height occur throughout the sheet.  
Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to December.  
The ungraded heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-mark, and may not be strictly in accordance with them.  
Tide-gauges are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.  
The kilometre scale numbers along roads and railways are shown in short type, e.g. '2' whereas kilometre numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. '25'.  
The sheet has been compiled from 1:25,000 surveys.  
The sheet has been corrected as a result of verification survey during 1982 in respect of communications as supplemented with information from vertical air photographs taken during 1978.
