MITIGATIVE MEASURES TO BE TAKENUP IN THE FOREST AREA PROPOSED TO BE DIVERTED (2.78 Ha) FOR WIDENING OF EXISTING ROAD FROM R&B ROAD TO ALLAMPALLY IN KAWAL RF OF UTNOOR(FDPT) DIVISION.

1. INTRODUCTION:

The total geographical area of the Adilabad District is 4,15,300 Ha and out of which the forest area is 1,83,000 Ha. which constitutes 44.06%. The total forest area Utnoor division is 42,227.63 Ha. The Unit consisting of (2) Ranges namely Birsaipet and Sirchelma Ranges. The Forest areas fall in Core and Buffer areas of Kawal Tiger Reserve.

The forest area in Utnoor FDPT Division is known for its diversified flora and fauna apart from scattered primitive tribal group habitations with unique tribal culture.

In the above scenario the District Panchayat Raj Engineer, Adilabad District submitted proposals for construction of Road from R7B road to Allampally in Kawal RF. The proposed road proposal falling in Utnoor FDPT Division (Area 2.78 Ha) Birsaipet KTR Range of Utnoor FDPT Division. The details are shown below:


Period of the Scheme:

The Conservation plan period is 3 years.

5. Objectives:

- 1. Protection and improvement of the eco-system through mitigative measures.
- Improvement of water resources through Soil & Moisture Conservation measures by catchment area treatment on watershed principles.
- Habitat improvement through improvement of fodder availability and protection from fire.
- 4. Publicity and awareness conservation education to the stakeholders for protecting Flora and Fauna.

Therefore it is mandatory for addressing the problems expected consequential for construction of Road from Muthnoor to Fakeernaik Thanda in Wildlife area in order to achieve the objectives the operations of Gap plantations and SMC works are proposed to improve the vegetation status in the area. Since it is a wildlife area, the wildlife



protection and habitat improvement works like fodder development, fire protection and publicity are proposed.
